

- March start planning your drills
- April-all policies gone thru every committee yet? Trauma, Pediatrics, MEC, Quality,
   Community Board? Every April Acura Grand Prix
- May is Decon month-in house then regional coalition drill
- June-August is floor by floor trainings- LB Pride Parade August
- **July** —the baby doctors arrive
- September -October community drills, classes, NGO meetings
- November and December- AARs and get ready for next year....
- Every month hospital new employee orientation
- Rinse and repeat- train baby yoda!





- Large events take time to plan
- Assure that the right people are notified and included in the drills
- Work with all community partners in the planning phase prior to a large scale event
- Never exclude any agencies
- Keep running drills till you get them right!!! Rinse and repeat!










# **Decon Drills**



### FBI Active Shooter Drill


- Drill focusing on the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Long Beach Fire Department responding with St. Mary Medical Center

Creating coordination between trauma center and all agencies in the city of Long Beach.








#### How did the LB FAA Airport drills get started?












# Now that you have mastered drills... BE THE VOICE! Speak out in your community




