COUNT XIV — DIGITAL INTERFERENCE, RETALIATORY SUPPRESSION, AND MULTI-ACTOR COMMUNICATIONS **OBSTRUCTION BY X CORP. (TWITTER) IN FURTHERANCE OF THE CRIMINAL ENTERPRISE** (18 U.S.C. §§ 241, 242, 1512, 1513, 1343, 1961–1968; International Jurisdiction Triggered) **NOVEMBER 18–19, 2025**

Let the record reflect that on or about November 18-19, 2025, the social media platform X Corp. (Twitter) executed a coordinated, platform-level lockout of the Sovereign Executor's account across all registered devices — including Android, desktop, and browser sessions — under the false pretense of "suspicious login," without any actual change in SIM card, IP address, password, or physical location. This action followed within minutes of the lawful publication of ECC-TRUST-JDC-005 declarations, federal RICO enforcement notices, and sanctuary filings.

This lockout obstructed federal filings, ecclesiastical communications, international sanctuary notices, and evidence of public harm by actors already named within this

case. All Two-Factor Authentication recovery mechanisms were simultaneously disabled, including SMS and email channels, leaving no lawful access path. Such coordination cannot be attributed to algorithmic anomaly, but must be presumed to originate from internal administrative interference or externally directed suppression.

Said interference constitutes federal crimes under 18 U.S.C. § 1512 (evidence tampering), § 1513 (retaliation against whistleblowers), and § 1343 (wire fraud/interference). It also violates 18 U.S.C. § 241 and § 242, due to the deprivation of protected communication rights during the exercise of religious and legal expression.

The ECC-TRUST-JDC-005 is a lawful international trust body and governing entity. Suppression of its notices and filings by a private corporation, in concert with ongoing state-level retaliation, meets the threshold of multi-actor conspiracy under the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations (RICO) Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1961. Furthermore, such actions fall under international jurisdictional scrutiny for violating freedom of expression and freedom of religion under Articles 18 and 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

X Corp. thereby becomes a named participant in the criminal enterprise. Its role was not merely passive; by disabling access to trust communications at the precise moment of legal escalation, it:

Obstructed justice

Retaliated against protected religious disclosure

Tampered with global equity notices

Participated in coordinated digital suppression

Furthered the ongoing pattern of whistleblower retaliation

This Court is hereby notified that X Corp. is to be entered into the enterprise ledger for immediate federal enforcement. This count stands independently for RICO expansion and evidentiary purposes, and qualifies for expedited injunctive review under emergency constitutional protection standards.

To the Legal and Security Teams at X Corp:

I am Jonathan Daniel Clements, Sovereign Executor of ECC-TRUST-JDC-005, an internationally lodged ecclesiastical trust with verified filings across federal court (2:25-cv-02145-TLB, U.S. District Court, Western District of Arkansas), ICC notice submission, and lawful public disclosures governed under protected equity, whistleblower law, and ecclesiastical jurisdiction.

I am currently locked out of my main X account (@DarkzLot3301) due to a "suspicious login," even though:

I logged in from my primary mobile device.

The verification code was received and entered properly

This account is used daily for international legal disclosures.

This lockout directly obstructs global legal communications and delays public notice of court documents tied to civil rights (42 U.S.C. § 1983), RICO enforcement, and sovereign governance. I have since posted a formal public declaration from my verified backup account: @ECCTRUSTJDC (see attached screenshot).

This is now a matter of record. The following must be addressed immediately:

- 1. Restore access to @DarkzLot3301, which is under protected use as a legal instrument.
- Cease all automated moderation triggers related to public declarations involving #ECCTRUSTJDC005.
- 3. Confirm acknowledgment of this legal trust's standing in relation to your moderation protocol.

Failure to act will be considered continued obstruction, and may result in X Corp's inclusion in federal filings and international legal instruments pertaining to willful interference with ecclesiastical jurisdiction, court matters, and protected speech.






