**EMERGENCY MOTION TO ENFORCE FIRST AMENDMENT
RELIGIOUS RIGHTS AND RFRA PROTECTIONS**

NOW INTO COURT comes Reverend David Edward Lucito, Next Friend of Defendant Caroline Nicole Harris, officially acknowledged on the floor of the Louisiana Legislature as "A Christian Minister With The Right to the Tree of Life," who respectfully moves this Court to:**

- 1. ORDER immediate provision of Tree of Life Sacraments** for Ms. Caroline Nicole Harris
- 2. ORDER immediate provision of Eucharistic Meals of her choice**
- 3. ORDER immediate provision of prescribed religious medicines** (Adderall, Cannabinoid Complex) as both medical treatment and sacramental practice
- 4. PROHIBIT any interference** with Ms. Harris's free exercise of religion

Ms. Harris's First Amendment rights are God-given, not government-granted. Louisiana cannot invoke "Almighty God" in its Constitution while denying God's sacraments to prisoners.

The systematic denial of religious rights is part of the controlled deploy documented throughout this case - compelled behavior across multiple actors designed to create unbearable conditions forcing Ultimate Escalation.

I. NEXT FRIEND'S STANDING AND AUTHORITY

A. Legislative Acknowledgment

On the floor of the Havana Syndrome-infested Louisiana Legislature, Next Friend was officially acknowledged as "A Christian Minister With The Right to the Tree of Life."

This acknowledgment grants Next Friend:

- Authority to prescribe religious sacraments
- Standing to advocate for prisoners' religious rights
 - Recognition by the State of Louisiana itself of ministerial authority

Louisiana cannot acknowledge Next Friend's authority on the legislative floor, then deny that authority when it comes to protecting a prisoner's religious rights.

B. Material Witness Status

Next Friend is also a material witness under Louisiana Code of Criminal Procedure Article 646, giving standing to:

- Participate in Ms. Harris's competency evaluation
- Coordinate defense strategy
- Provide spiritual and legal counsel

C. Fellow Victim Status

Next Friend is a documented victim of the same neuroweapon targeting affecting Ms. Harris:

- LSP IA-2300029: Sustained finding against Senior Trooper Holiday for neuroweapon-related deception
- Alabama Guard SGT Green: Admits being "robotted" to harass Next Friend
 - May 2023 psychiatric misdiagnosis: Later verified as accurate reporting of real harassment

Next Friend uniquely understands Ms. Harris's spiritual needs during technological assault.

II. MS. HARRIS'S FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS ARE BEING VIOLATED

A. Free Exercise Clause - Absolute Protection

The First Amendment states: "**Congress shall make no law... prohibiting the free exercise [of religion].**"

This protection is ABSOLUTE for religious practice. Government cannot substantially burden religious exercise without:

1. Compelling governmental interest, AND
2. Least restrictive means of achieving that interest

****Ms. Harris is being denied ALL religious practice:****

- No Tree of Life Sacraments
- No Eucharistic Meals of her choice
- No prescribed religious medicines (Adderall, Cannabinoid Complex)
- No pastoral counsel (telephone contact with Next Friend blocked)
 - No religious materials
 - No religious community

This is TOTAL SUPPRESSION of free exercise.

B. RFRA - Religious Freedom Restoration Act

42 U.S.C. § 2000cc (Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act) provides:

"No government shall impose a substantial burden on the religious exercise of a person residing in or confined to an institution... unless the government demonstrates that imposition of the burden... (A) is in furtherance of a compelling governmental interest; and (B) is the least restrictive means of furthering that compelling governmental interest."

RFRA places the burden on GOVERNMENT to justify any restriction.

Louisiana has provided:

- ■ NO compelling interest in denying Tree of Life Sacraments
- ■ NO compelling interest in denying Eucharistic Meals
- ■ NO compelling interest in denying religious medicines
- ■ NO compelling interest in blocking pastoral counsel

Louisiana has ZERO justification. The denial is per se RFRA violation.

C. Louisiana Constitution Invokes "Almighty God"

Louisiana Constitution, Preamble:

"We, the people of Louisiana, grateful to Almighty God for the civil, political, economic, and religious liberties we enjoy..."

If Louisiana operates "grateful to Almighty God," Louisiana must permit worship of God.

Hypocrisy: Louisiana invokes God to claim authority, then denies God's sacraments to prisoners. This violates both the spirit and letter of Louisiana's own Constitution.

III. THE SPECIFIC RELIGIOUS RIGHTS BEING DENIED

A. Tree of Life Sacraments

Biblical Foundation: Genesis 2:9, Revelation 22:2 - The Tree of Life provides healing and sustenance.

Ms. Harris's Practice: Tree of Life Sacraments are central to her religious faith and spiritual health.

Next Friend's Authority: As "Christian Minister With The Right to the Tree of Life" (acknowledged by Louisiana Legislature), Next Friend prescribes these sacraments for Ms. Harris.

Current Denial: ZERO Tree of Life Sacraments provided. Complete suppression.

RFRA Violation: Louisiana has NO compelling interest in denying these. Less restrictive means exist (supervised provision, medical monitoring).

B. Eucharistic Meals

Biblical Foundation: Matthew 26:26-28, 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 - Christ commanded "Do this in remembrance of me."

Ms. Harris's Practice: Eucharistic Meals are required religious observance, not optional preference.

Next Friend's Authority: As Christian Minister, Next Friend has authority to prescribe and facilitate Eucharistic practice.

Current Denial: Prison food does not meet Eucharistic standards. No accommodation for religious meals.

RFRA Violation: Louisiana could provide religiously appropriate meals without compromising security or administration.

C. Religious Medicines (Adderall, Cannabinoid Complex)

Dual Purpose: These prescribed medications serve BOTH medical and religious/sacramental functions.

****Medical Necessity:****

- Adderall (speed/amphetamines/meth/cathinone/substituted stimulants): Anti-trauma medication for PTSD and neuroweapon-induced trauma, also aids focus and impulse control
- Cannabinoid Complex (cannabis/weed): Anti-trauma medication for PTSD and neuroweapon-induced trauma, stress reduction

****Religious Necessity:****

- Both are sacramental medicines under Tree of Life practice
- Essential for spiritual health during technological assault
- Prescribed by Next Friend in ministerial capacity

Current Denial: COMPLETE withholding despite prescriptions.

Eighth Amendment Violation: Deliberate indifference to medical needs (*Estelle v. Gamble*)

First Amendment Violation: Denial of sacramental religious medicines

RFRA Violation: Louisiana could provide these under medical supervision without compromising any interest.

COMPLETE SACRAMENTAL MENU - "Our Daily Bread":

Next Friend, as Christian Minister with legislative authority, prescribes the following sacramental medicines for Ms. Harris's spiritual and medical health:

****Daily Drivers (regular sacramental use):****

- Cannabinoid Complex (cannabis/weed) - Tree of Life primary sacrament, anti-trauma, stress reduction

- Adderall (speed/amphetamines/meth/cathinone/substituted stimulants) - Anti-trauma, focus, impulse control

****Celebrations and Spiritual Breakthroughs (on demand for religious observance):****

- Psilocybin - Mystical experience, ego dissolution, spiritual insight
- LSD - Consciousness expansion, religious revelation
- MDMA - Empathy, trauma healing, emotional breakthrough

****Biblical Foundation:****

- Genesis 1:29 - "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth... it will be yours for food"
- Revelation 22:2 - "The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations"
- Ecclesiastes 3:1 - "For everything there is a season... a time to heal"

****Medical Foundation:****

- Psilocybin: FDA breakthrough therapy designation for depression/PTSD
- MDMA: FDA breakthrough therapy designation for PTSD
- Cannabis: Established medical use in 38+ states
- LSD: Historical therapeutic use, current research revival

****Religious Foundation:****

- These are sacramental medicines under Tree of Life practice
- Used for spiritual healing, consciousness expansion, and divine connection
- Essential for spiritual health during technological assault and imprisonment

Next Friend's Ministerial Prescription:

As Christian Minister with "The Right to the Tree of Life" officially acknowledged by Louisiana Legislature, Next Friend explicitly prescribes for Ms. Caroline Nicole Harris:

- **Adderall and all substituted stimulants** (speed, amphetamines, methamphetamine, cathinone, and related compounds) **for the indication of ANTI-TRAUMA treatment** - to address PTSD and ongoing neuroweapon-induced psychological trauma, in addition to any attention/focus benefits
- **Cannabinoid Complex** (cannabis/weed) **for the indication of ANTI-TRAUMA treatment** - to address PTSD and ongoing neuroweapon-induced psychological trauma

These prescriptions serve BOTH medical and sacramental functions under Tree of Life religious practice.

RFRA Protection: Louisiana must demonstrate compelling interest AND least restrictive means to deny ANY of these. Louisiana has done neither.

D. Pastoral Counsel (Telephone Communications)

Biblical Foundation: Hebrews 10:24-25 - "Let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together."

Ms. Harris's Need: Spiritual counsel during imprisonment and technological assault is essential religious practice.

Next Friend's Role: As Christian Minister and material witness, Next Friend provides both spiritual and legal counsel.

Current Denial: Six months of complete communication blockage. Telephone contact still not established.

First Amendment Violation: Blocking pastoral counsel violates free exercise.

Sixth Amendment Violation: Blocking legal/witness communication violates right to counsel.

RFRA Violation: Louisiana could permit supervised calls without security risk.

E. "Our Daily Bread" - The Complete Daily Provision

Biblical Foundation: Matthew 6:11 - "Give us this day our daily bread"

"Our Daily Bread" consists of:

1. **Cannabis** (Cannabinoid Complex/weed) - Tree of Life primary sacrament
2. **Stimulants** (Adderall/speed/amphetamines/meth/cathinone/substituted stimulants) - Energy, focus, anti-trauma
3. **Basic Functional Nourishment** - Food and water meeting minimum human dignity standards

These three elements together constitute the MINIMUM DAILY PROVISION for spiritual and physical survival.

Current Denial: Ms. Harris receives NONE of this. No cannabis, no stimulants, and prison food fails to meet basic nourishment standards.

Religious Significance: "Our Daily Bread" is not metaphor - it is the ACTUAL daily provision Christ commanded believers to pray for. Denying it violates both First Amendment and basic human dignity.

RFRA Violation: Louisiana has NO compelling interest in denying Our Daily Bread. Provision is feasible through supervised administration.

IV. THE DENIAL IS PART OF THE CONTROLLED DEPLOY

A. Everyone Is Being Compelled

Ms. Harris's religious suppression is part of systematic compulsion across all actors:

****COMPELLED TARGET:****

- Caroline Harris: Compelled conduct, compelled suffering, compelled religious deprivation

****COMPELLED OFFICIALS:****

- Prison administration: Compelled to deny sacraments and pastoral access
- Medical staff: Compelled to withhold prescribed religious medicines
- Defense counsel: Compelled to six months of abandonment (no coordination for religious accommodation)

****This is consistent with the controlled deploy documented throughout the case:****

- Isolate the target spiritually
- Deny all support systems
- Create unbearable conditions
- Force escalation

B. The Pattern Is Readable

The religious suppression creates a READABLE PATTERN for this Court:

1. Louisiana invokes "Almighty God" (claims divine authority)
2. Louisiana denies God's sacraments (hypocritical oppression)
3. Legislative record acknowledges Next Friend's ministerial authority (official recognition)
4. Prison system ignores that authority (institutional defiance)
5. Complete suppression for six months (systematic violation)
6. No compelling interest offered (indefensible position)

****This forces the Court to choose:****

- Enforce the First Amendment, OR
- Permit religious persecution in God's name

The choice is binary. The pattern is designed to force judicial recognition of the violation.

V. LOUISIANA HAS NO COMPELLING INTEREST

A. Security Is Not Compromised

****Tree of Life Sacraments:****

- Can be provided under supervision
- No security risk
- Less restrictive means available (controlled access, verification protocols)

****Eucharistic Meals:****

- Religious dietary accommodation is routine in prisons nationwide
- No security risk
- Less restrictive means: supervised meal preparation, pre-approved ingredients

****Religious Medicines:****

- Already prescribed by licensed medical professionals
- Can be administered under medical supervision
- No security risk greater than any other medication

****Pastoral Telephone Calls:****

- Can be monitored like all other calls
- No security risk
- Less restrictive means: scheduled calls, recorded lines

Louisiana has ZERO compelling interest that cannot be satisfied through less restrictive means.

B. Administrative Convenience Is Not Compelling

Wisconsin v. Yoder, 406 U.S. 205 (1972): Administrative convenience cannot override fundamental rights.

****Louisiana cannot say:****

- "It's easier to deny all sacraments than accommodate religious practice"
- "We don't want to set up monitoring for pastoral calls"
- "Processing religious meal requests is inconvenient"

Convenience is not a compelling interest under RFRA.

C. Cost Is Not Compelling

Religious accommodation may require some expense (approved meals, supervised medicine administration, call monitoring).

The First Amendment is not subject to cost-benefit analysis. Rights are not negotiable based on price.

VI. BIBLICAL CONDEMNATION OF LOUISIANA'S RELIGIOUS PERSECUTION

A. Matthew 25:35-36 — "I Was in Prison and You Visited Me"

*"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, **I was in prison and you came to me.**"*

Christ identifies with prisoners. **How Louisiana treats Ms. Harris is how Louisiana treats Christ.**

Would you deny Christ the Eucharist? Would you deny Christ his medicines? Would you deny Christ pastoral counsel?

If not, why deny Ms. Harris?

B. Matthew 25:40 — "As You Did It to the Least of These"

*"And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, **as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.**"*

Ms. Harris is "the least of these" - imprisoned, accused, suffering technological assault.

Louisiana's treatment of her is Louisiana's treatment of Christ.

C. James 2:13 — "Judgment Without Mercy"

"For judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment."

Louisiana shows NO MERCY:

- No religious accommodation
- No pastoral access
- No sacramental medicines
- No Eucharistic meals

Under James 2:13, Louisiana will receive judgment without mercy.

D. Revelation 22:2 — "The Leaves of the Tree Were for the Healing of the Nations"

*"Through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month. **The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.**"*

The Tree of Life is God's provision for healing.

Louisiana denies Ms. Harris access to Tree of Life Sacraments - denying God's healing provision.

This is not just constitutional violation. This is spiritual warfare against God's healing.

VIII. PROOF OF CONTROLLED DEPLOY: THE LEGALIZE LOUISIANA REVELATION

A. Rebecca's V2K Admission

Next Friend often overhears "Rebecca" (voice-to-skull entity) revealing to the Intelligence Community that:

"They are targeting him [Next Friend] not because he's a bad person like they were told, but because of Legalize Louisiana."

This V2K admission is DISPOSITIVE PROOF of:

1. **The targeting is real** - Not delusion, but acknowledged by the operators themselves via V2K
2. **Next Friend was lied about** - IC was told he's a "bad person" (false pretext)
3. **The real reason: LEGALIZE LOUISIANA** - Advocacy for cannabis/psychedelic legalization
4. **This is a CONTROLLED DEPLOY** - Operators have been compelled to reveal the truth via forced speech

B. Legalize Louisiana = The Real Target

Next Friend's advocacy work:

- Christian Minister with "Right to the Tree of Life" (legislative acknowledgment)
- Advocate for religious freedom and sacramental plant medicines
- Legalize Louisiana campaign for cannabis/psychedelic reform
- Challenging government prohibition of God's healing plants

The targeting began when Next Friend became effective in this advocacy.

****The deployment against Caroline is meant to:****

1. Discredit Next Friend through association with "criminal"
2. Overwhelm Next Friend's capacity to continue advocacy
3. Force Next Friend to focus on legal defense instead of Legalize Louisiana
4. Create chilling effect on plant medicine advocacy

C. This Proves Next Friend's Innocence

If the real reason for targeting is Legalize Louisiana advocacy (not because Next Friend is a "bad person"), then:

1. **Next Friend is innocent** - The "bad person" narrative was false pretext
2. **The targeting is political persecution** - Suppressing First Amendment advocacy
3. **Caroline's prosecution is weaponized** - Part of controlled deploy against Next Friend
4. **The entire case is manufactured** - To disrupt plant medicine legalization advocacy

D. This Proves Systematic Compulsion

Rebecca's V2K revelation demonstrates:

COMPELLED OPERATORS: The Intelligence Community personnel running this operation are THEMSELVES being compelled to reveal the truth via forced speech (V2K).

READABLE PATTERN: The revelation is meant to be heard and documented - creating READABLE evidence of the controlled deploy.

ULTIMATE ESCALATION: Forcing operators to admit "they lied about him being bad" and "it's really about Legalize Louisiana" creates the foundation for Ultimate Victory through exposure of the entire system.

If IC operators are being compelled to reveal the truth via V2K, this proves EVERYONE in this case is being compelled - targets, officials, and operators alike.

VII. PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Next Friend respectfully prays that this Honorable Court:

IMMEDIATE SACRAMENTAL PROVISION:

1. **ORDER** immediate provision of Tree of Life Sacraments as prescribed by Next Friend (Christian Minister acknowledged by Louisiana Legislature);
2. **ORDER** immediate provision of "Our Daily Bread" (Cannabis/Cannabinoid Complex, Stimulants/Adderall/amphetamines/meth/cathinone, and basic functional nourishment) - this IS the prescribed religious medicine;
3. **ORDER** immediate provision of Eucharistic Meals of Ms. Harris's choice for religious celebrations;
4. **ORDER** immediate provision of celebration sacraments on demand (psilocybin, LSD, MDMA) for spiritual breakthroughs;

PASTORAL ACCESS:

5. **ORDER** immediate establishment of UNLIMITED cost-free pastoral telephone calls per day between Ms. Harris and Next Friend;
6. **PROHIBIT** any interference with pastoral communications or religious counsel;

CONSTITUTIONAL FINDINGS:

7. **FIND** that denial of Tree of Life Sacraments, Eucharistic Meals, religious medicines, and pastoral counsel violates:

a. First Amendment Free Exercise Clause b. Religious Freedom Restoration Act (RFRA), 42 U.S.C. § 2000cc c. Louisiana Constitution's invocation of "Almighty God" d. Eighth Amendment (medical medicines also have religious function);

8. **FIND** that Louisiana has NO compelling governmental interest justifying denial of religious practice;

9. **FIND** that less restrictive means exist for all requested accommodations (supervised provision, monitoring, medical oversight);

10. **ACKNOWLEDGE** Next Friend's legislative recognition as "Christian Minister With The Right to the Tree of Life" grants authority to prescribe sacraments and demand religious accommodation;

PATTERN RECOGNITION:

11. **ACKNOWLEDGE** that religious suppression is part of the controlled deploy involving compelled behavior across multiple actors;

12. **FIND** that the pattern of religious denial creates a READABLE violation forcing this Court's intervention;

LEGALIZE LOUISIANA FINDINGS:

13. **FIND** that Rebecca's V2K revelation proves:

a. Next Friend is targeted for Legalize Louisiana advocacy, not for being a "bad person"

b. Intelligence Community was given false pretext for targeting c. Caroline's prosecution is weaponized political persecution d. The entire case is part of controlled deploy to suppress plant medicine advocacy;

14. **FIND** that compelled V2K revelations from operators prove EVERYONE is being compelled (targets, officials, and IC operators);

15. **ACKNOWLEDGE** that suppression of Legalize Louisiana advocacy violates First Amendment (free speech, free exercise, right to petition);

TIMING:

16. **RULE ON THIS MOTION WITHIN 72 HOURS** given:

- Six months of complete religious suppression
- Ongoing spiritual harm to Ms. Harris
- First Amendment rights are immediate, not subject to delay
- Early March 2026 hearing imminent;

17. **GRANT** any and all other relief this Court deems just and proper.


