1. D/Pub has been finding the procedures for clearing 25X1X7 CIA publications for increasingly unsatisfactory. Not only is there no clearly defined policy based on a wellconsidered rationale for clearance procedure, but D/Pub and the Inspection and Security Staff appear to have been given overlapping responsibilities. Judging by documents 25X1X7 passing through D/Pub, CIA owes it to to provide them with the best possible service. Present practice makes it impossible to do this.

2. D/Pub therefore recommends that a policy for clearing these publications be drawn up for the approval of the DCI and that a simple, clean-cut procedure be established for such clearance, either with or without the participation of D/Pub. 25X1A9a of S/PP has agreed that drawing up such a policy and procedure is properly the task of his organization.
