Nested If, If-Else

Tasks:

- 1. A library charges a fine for every book returned late.
 - For the first 5 days, the fine is 50 paise,
 - For 6-10 days fine is one rupee and above 10 days fine is 5 rupees. If you return the book after 30 days your membership will be canceled.

Write a program to accept the number of days the member is late to return the book and display the fine or the appropriate message.

Your role is to help students select an ideal mentorship stream aligned with their interests and skills. I. If Strong Coding (S):
