CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- MUST** be a United States citizen
- MUST** 18 years of age or older by June 1, 2023
- MUST** have NOT been determined by a final judgement of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote (*Office of the City Clerk Internet Posting Requirement Posted 2021.05.05 Rev 2022.12.07 Page 2 of 2*)
- MUST** have NOT been finally convicted of a felony from which the candidate has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- MUST** have resided continuously in Texas for 12 months by the February 17, 2023, deadline to file an Application for a Place on the Ballot
- MUST** have resided continuously in San Antonio for 12 months by the date of filing his/her Application for a Place on the Ballot
- MUST** be a qualified registered voter of San Antonio by the February 17, 2023, deadline to file an Application for a Place on the Ballot
- MUST** have resided in the city council district at least 6 months by the date of filing his/her Application for a Place on the Ballot * *If your residence was not previously in San Antonio or no longer in the city council district you are seeking due to redistricting, you MUST have resided at your residence at least 6 months prior to the boundary change.*
- MUST** continue to reside in San Antonio and the respective city council district during his/her entire term of office. Failure to reside in the City and respective council district during his/her entire term of office shall render the council district vacant
