Methodology: polling

J.L. Partners polled a nationally representative sample of 1,001 registered voters.

- Fieldwork date of February 24th – 25th 2025
- Sample of 1,001 registered voters collected online
- Quotas were added to ensure representative data:
 - On region, 2024 presidential vote, partisan ID, age, gender, ethnicity, education and density
- The sample was weighted back to the population using data on the same variables:
 - On region, 2024 presidential vote, partisan ID, age, gender, ethnicity, education and density
- 10-minute duration
- Margin of error: 3.4%

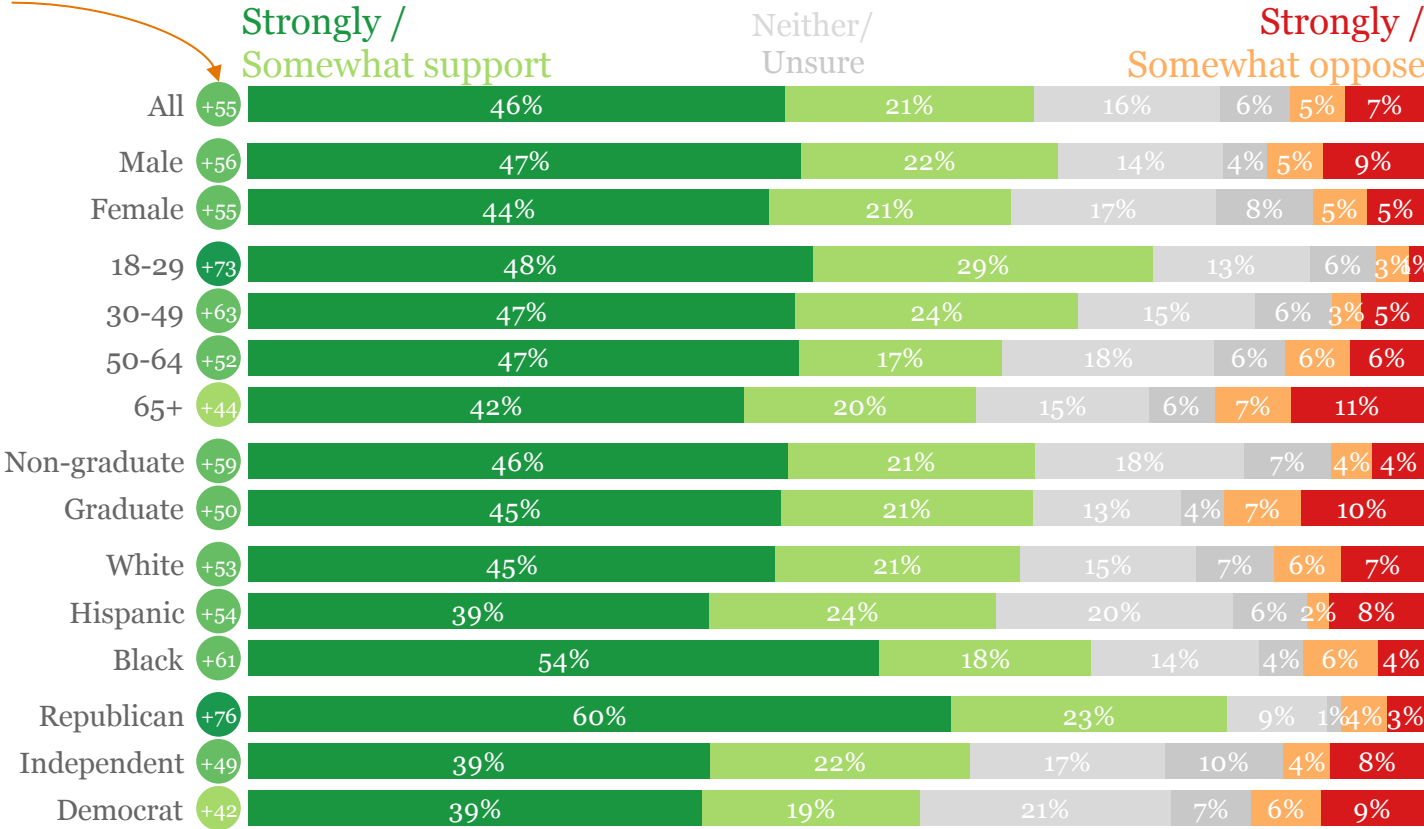


Support for the DOGE dividend

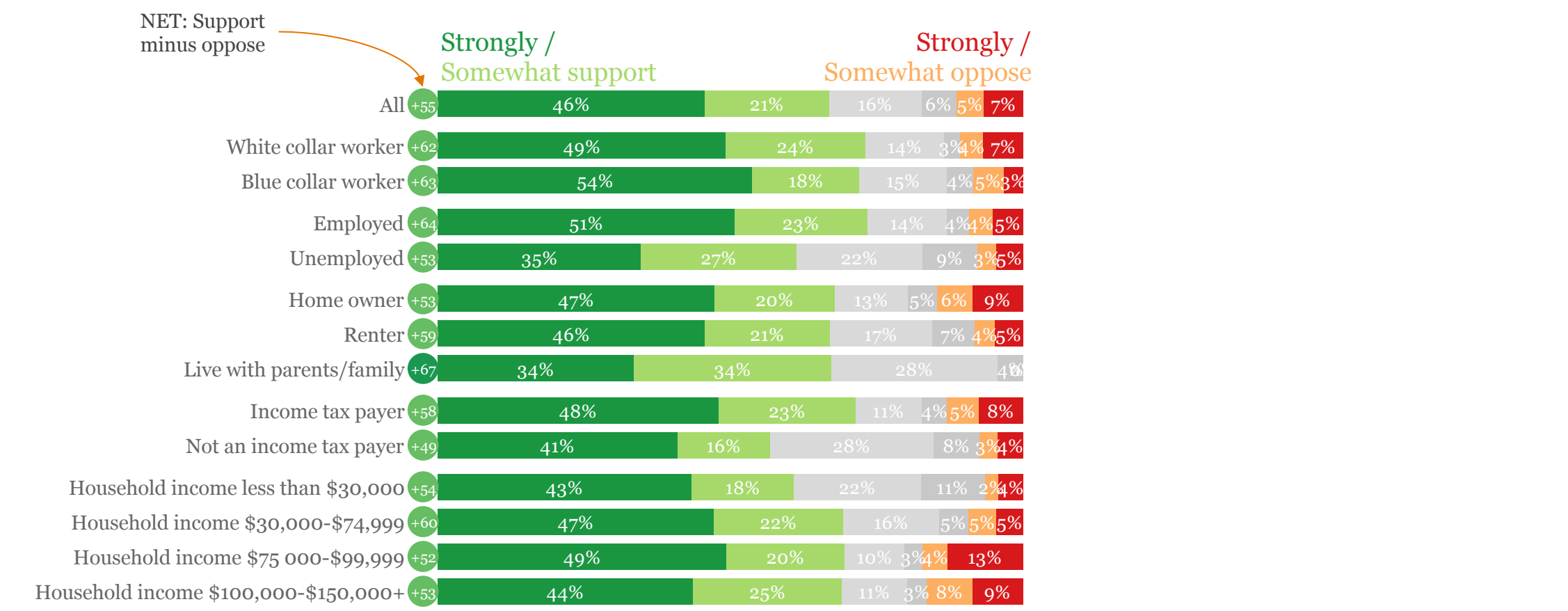

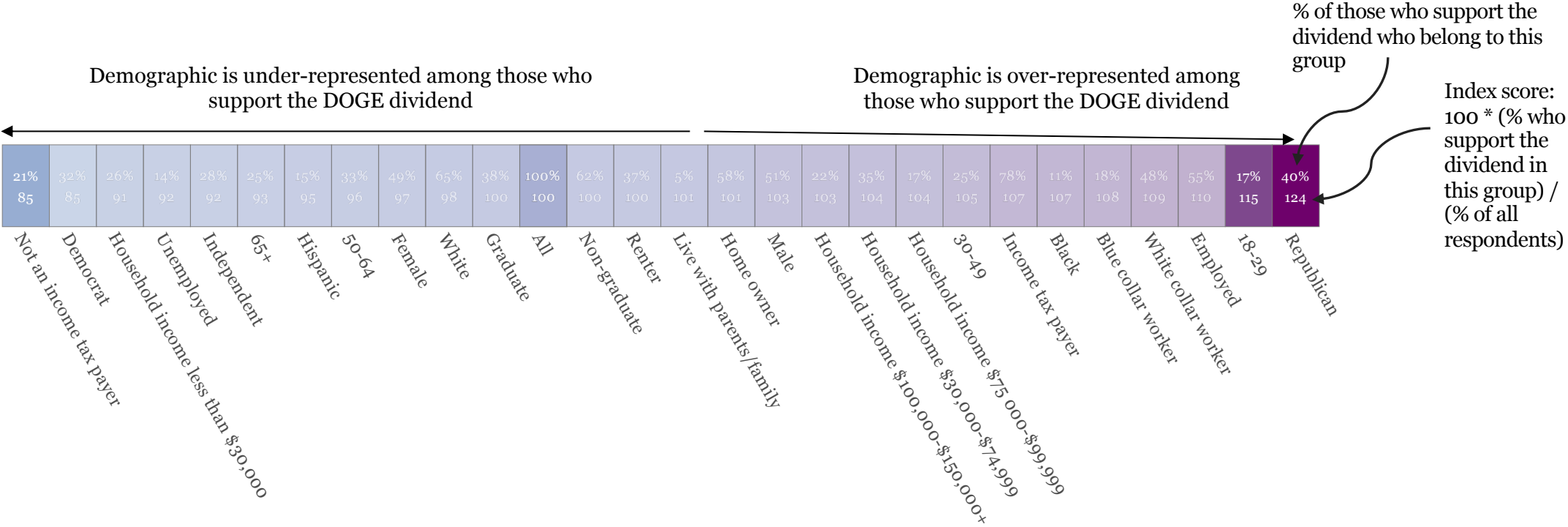
White collar and blue collar workers back the move, as do those on either end of the income scale

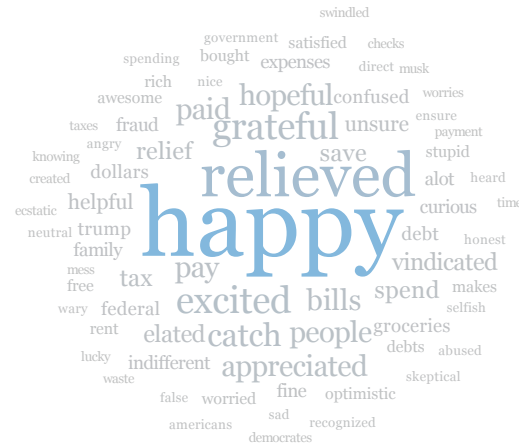

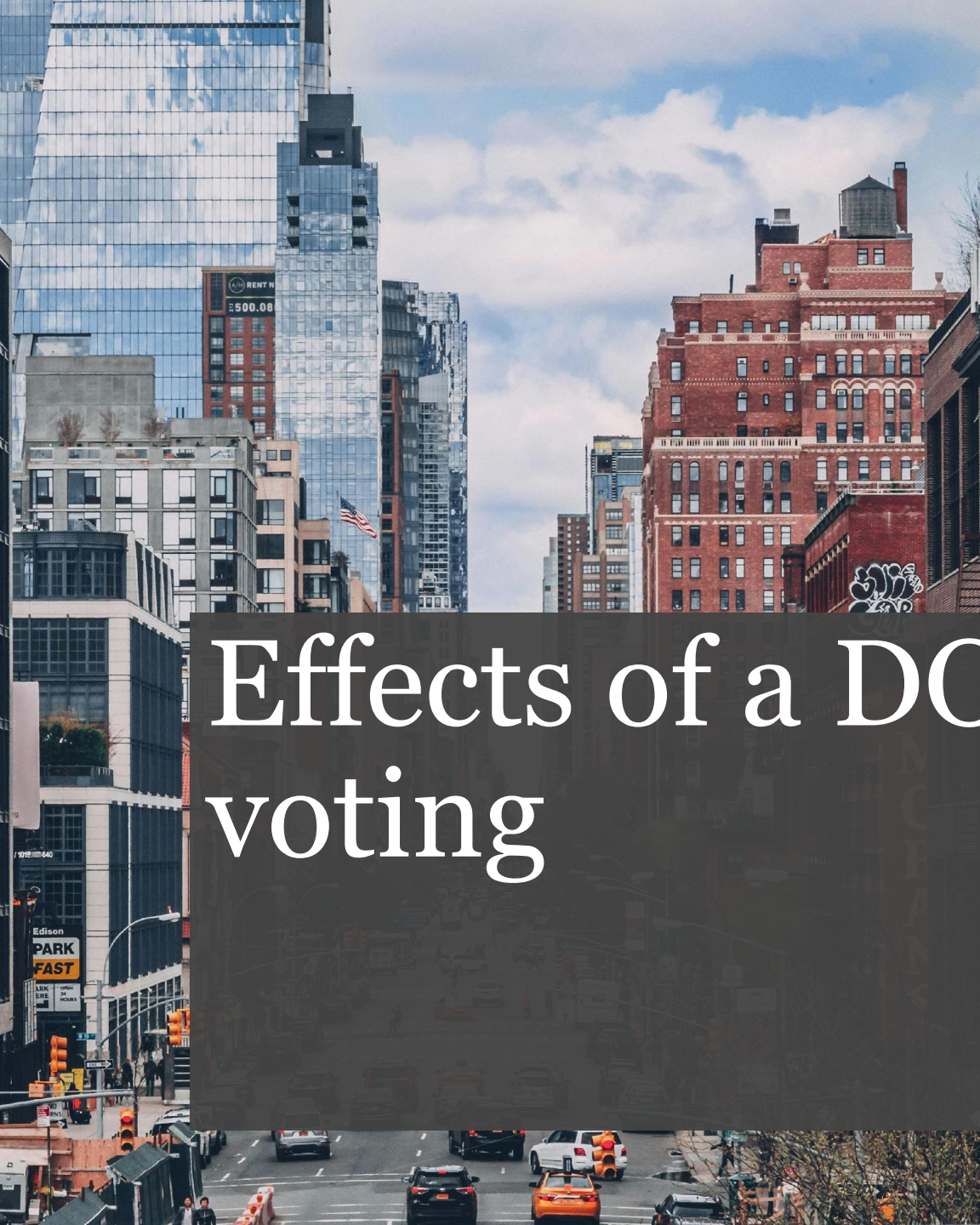

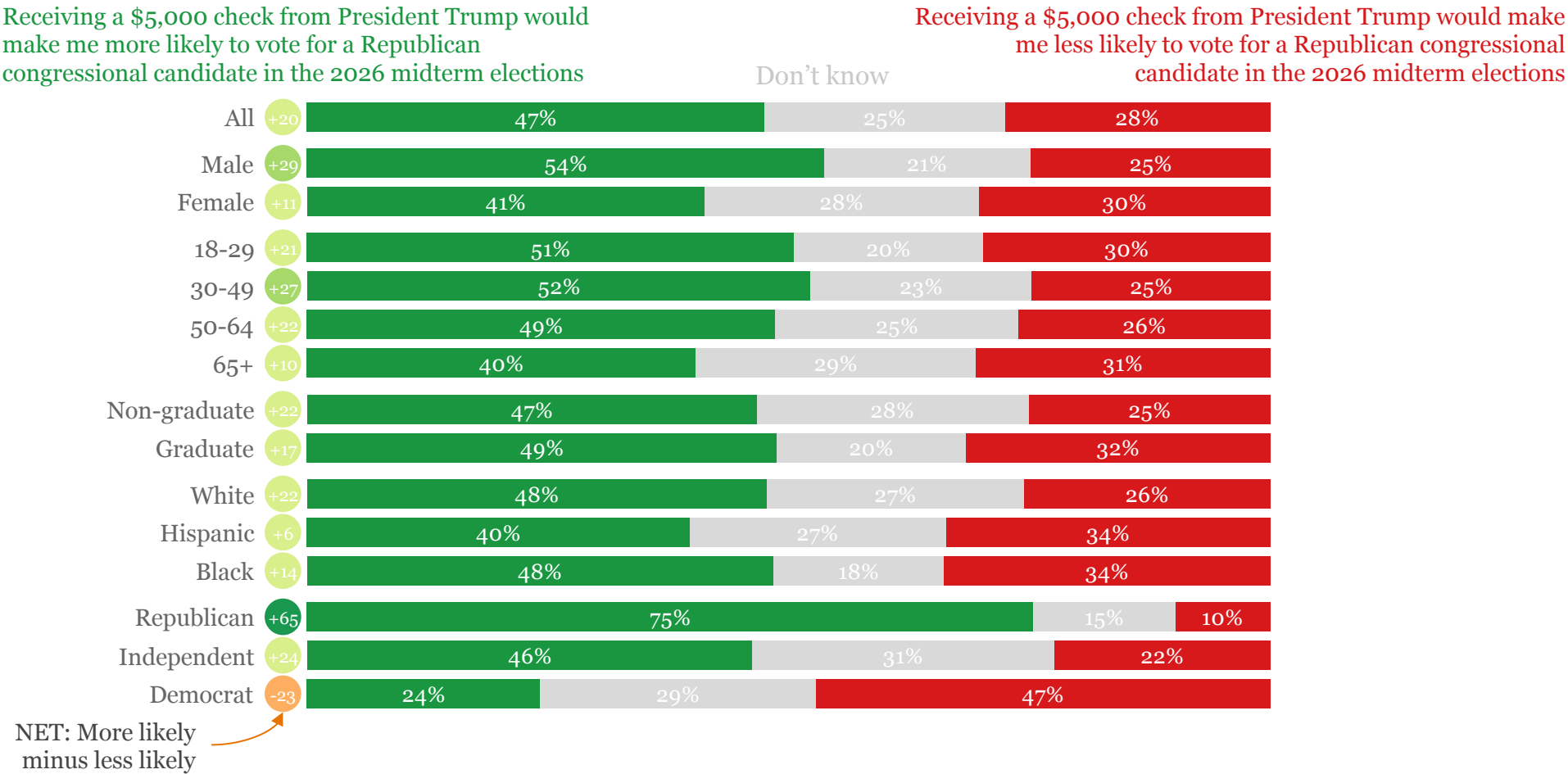

1 in 4 Democrats and almost half of independents say receiving the dividend will make them more likely to vote for a Republican congressional candidate

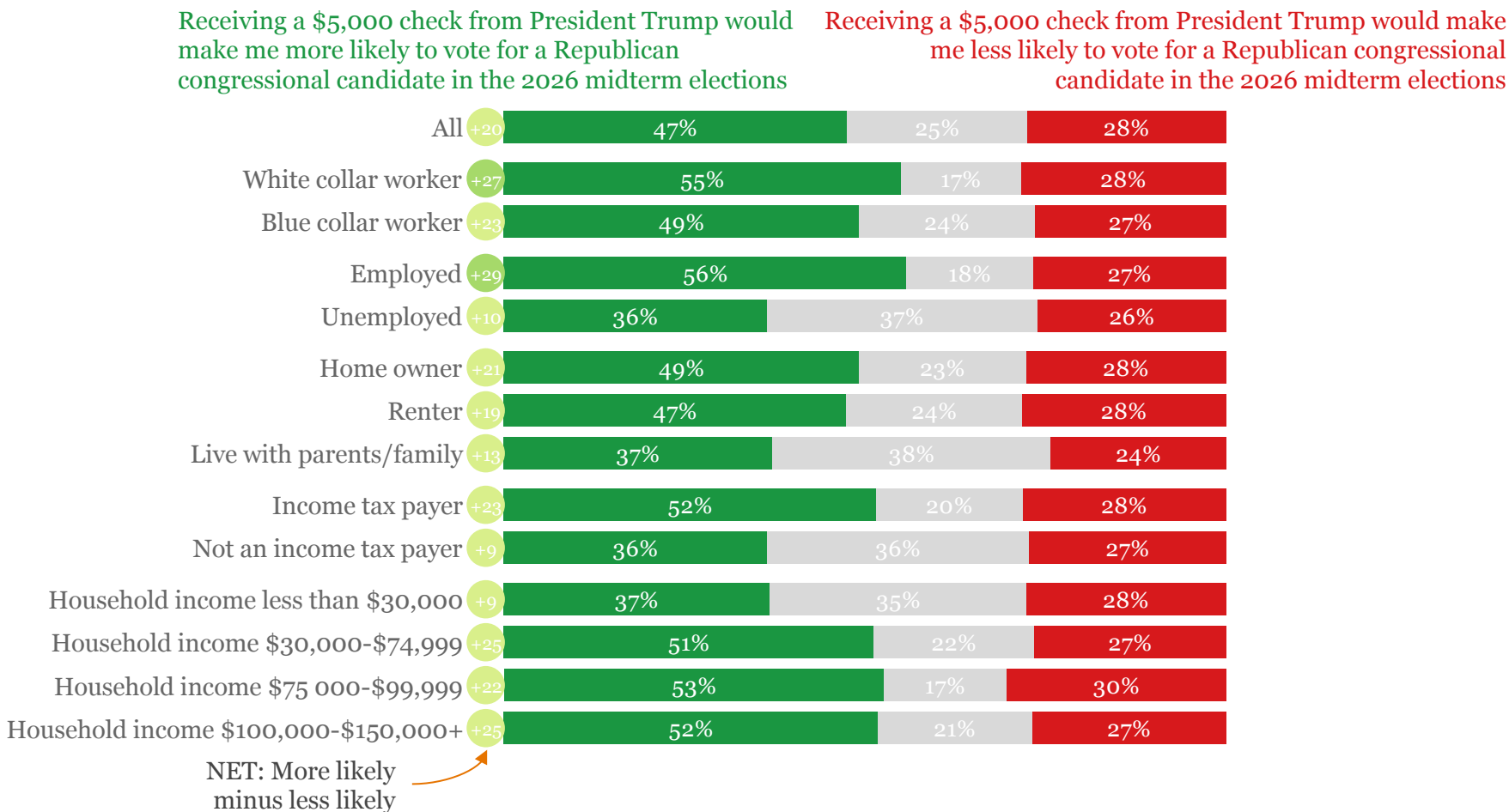

Both blue collar and white collar workers say the dividend will make them more likely to vote for a Republican

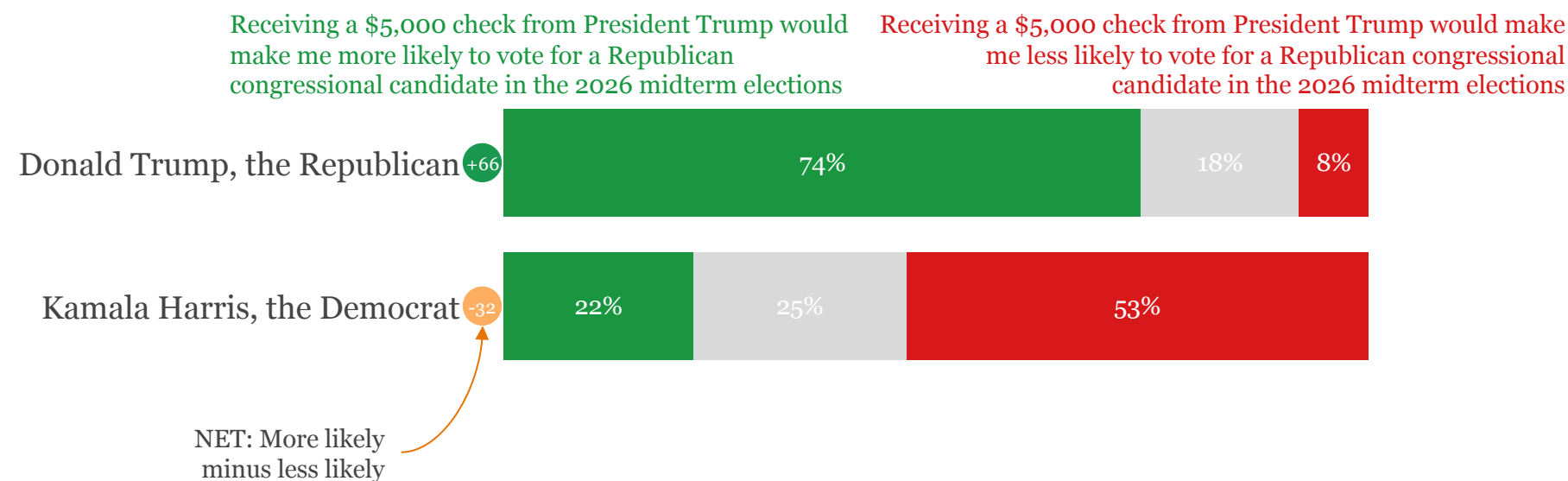

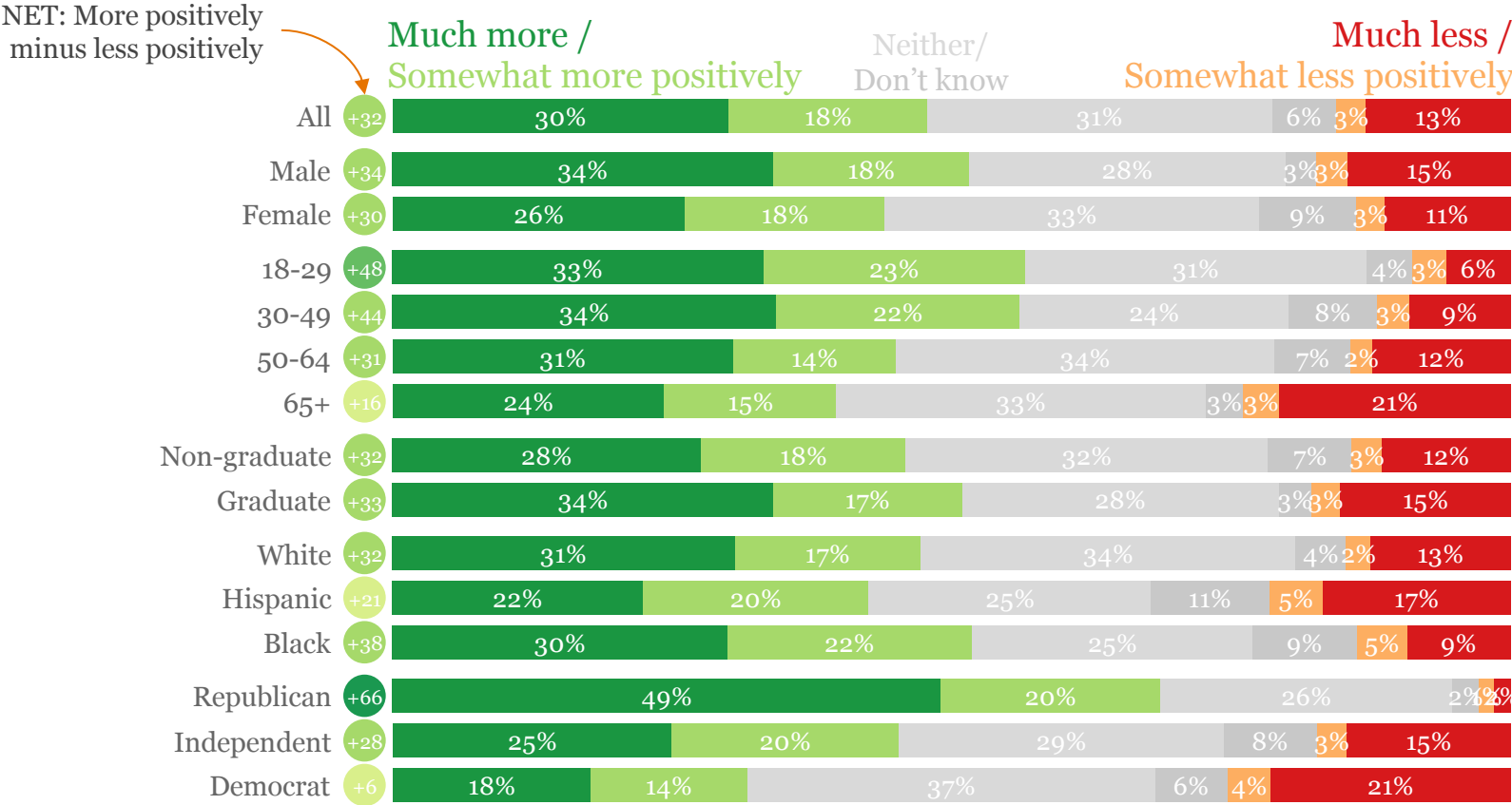

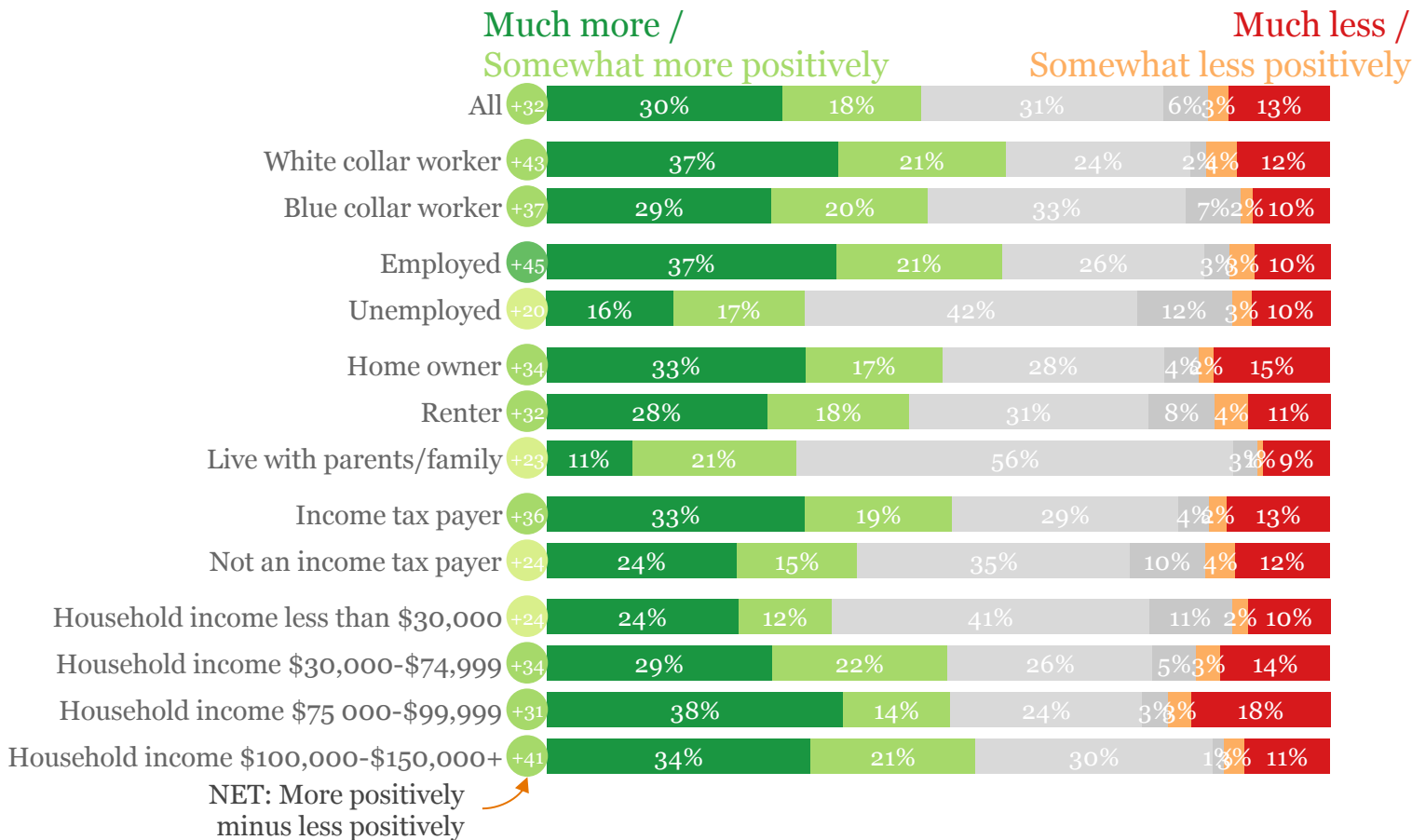

Americans overall, especially white collar workers, say that they would feel more positively towards President Trump if they received the check

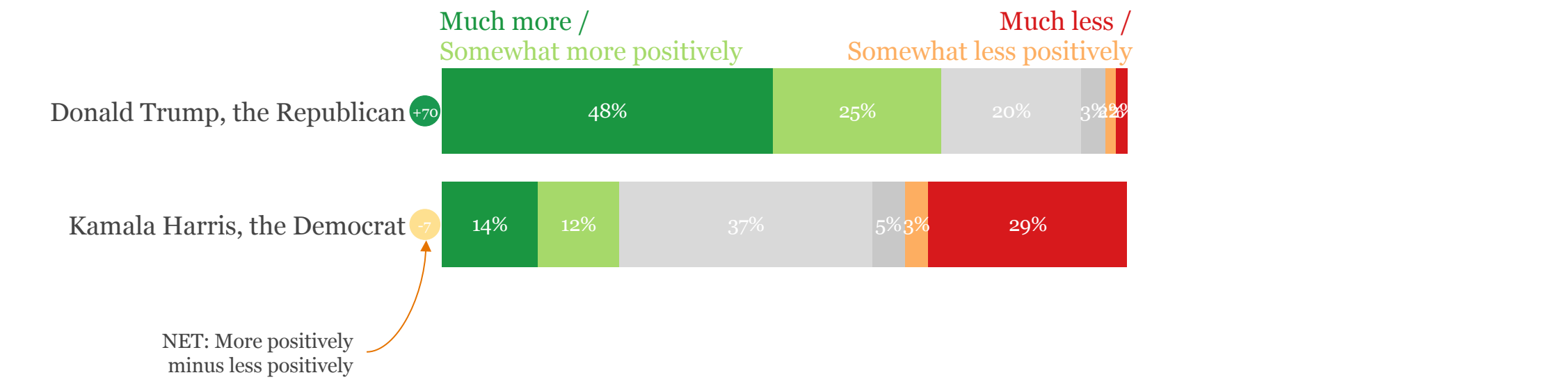

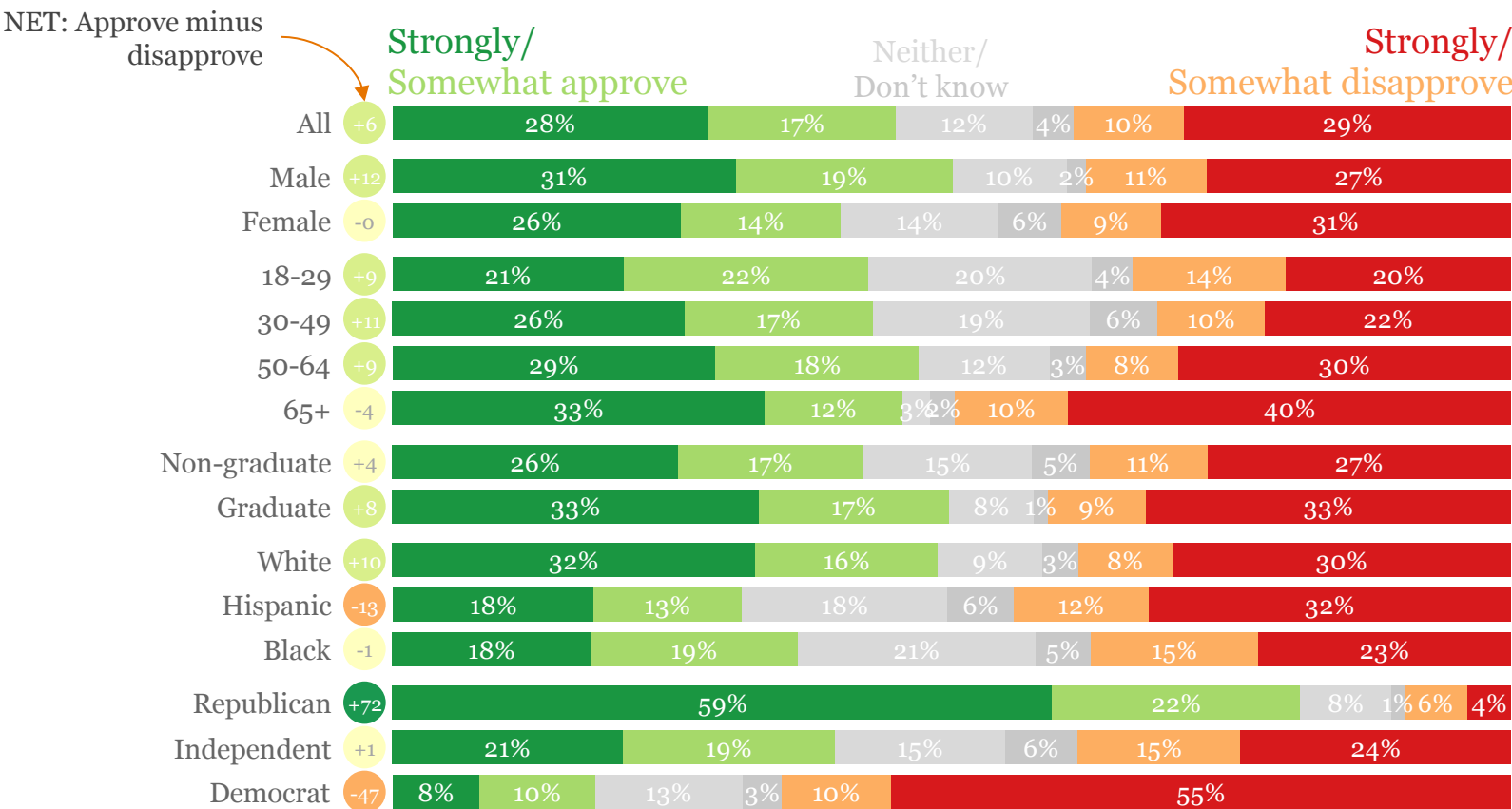

Trump has a +6 approval rating after his first month

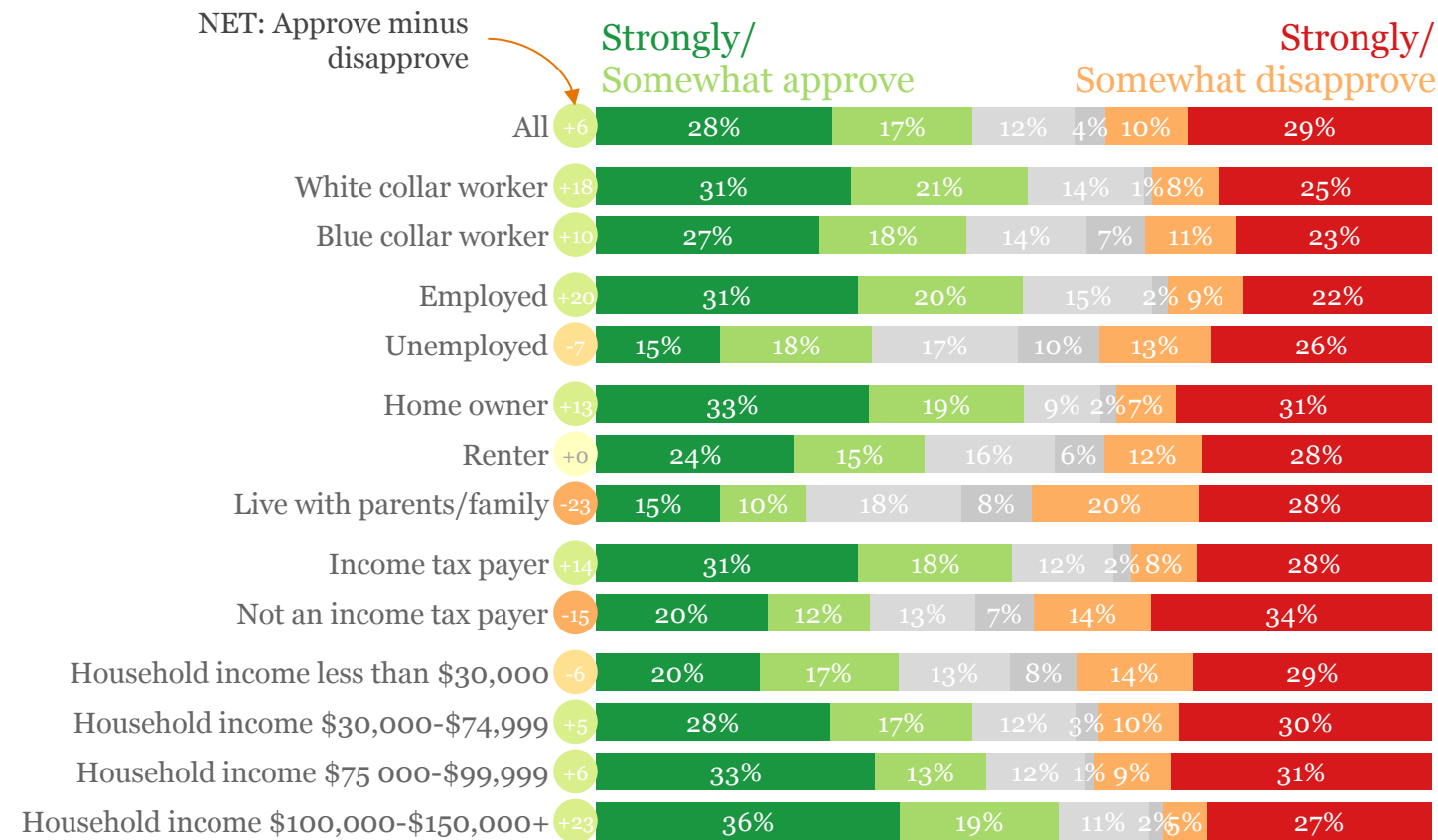
Do you approve or disapprove of the job that President Donald Trump has done in his first month in office?

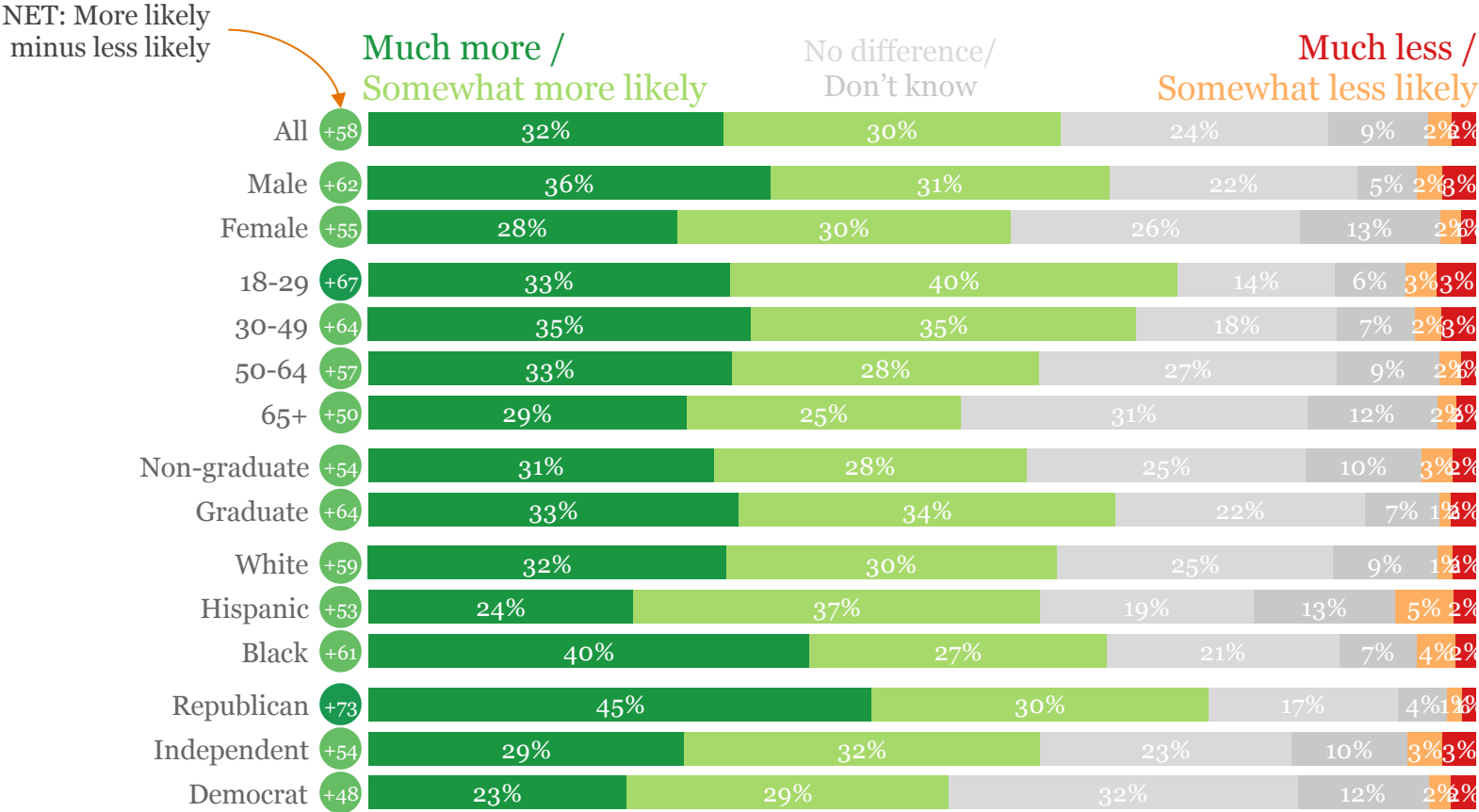

Even Democrats think that the check would make Americans more likely to report examples of government waste, fraud and abuse

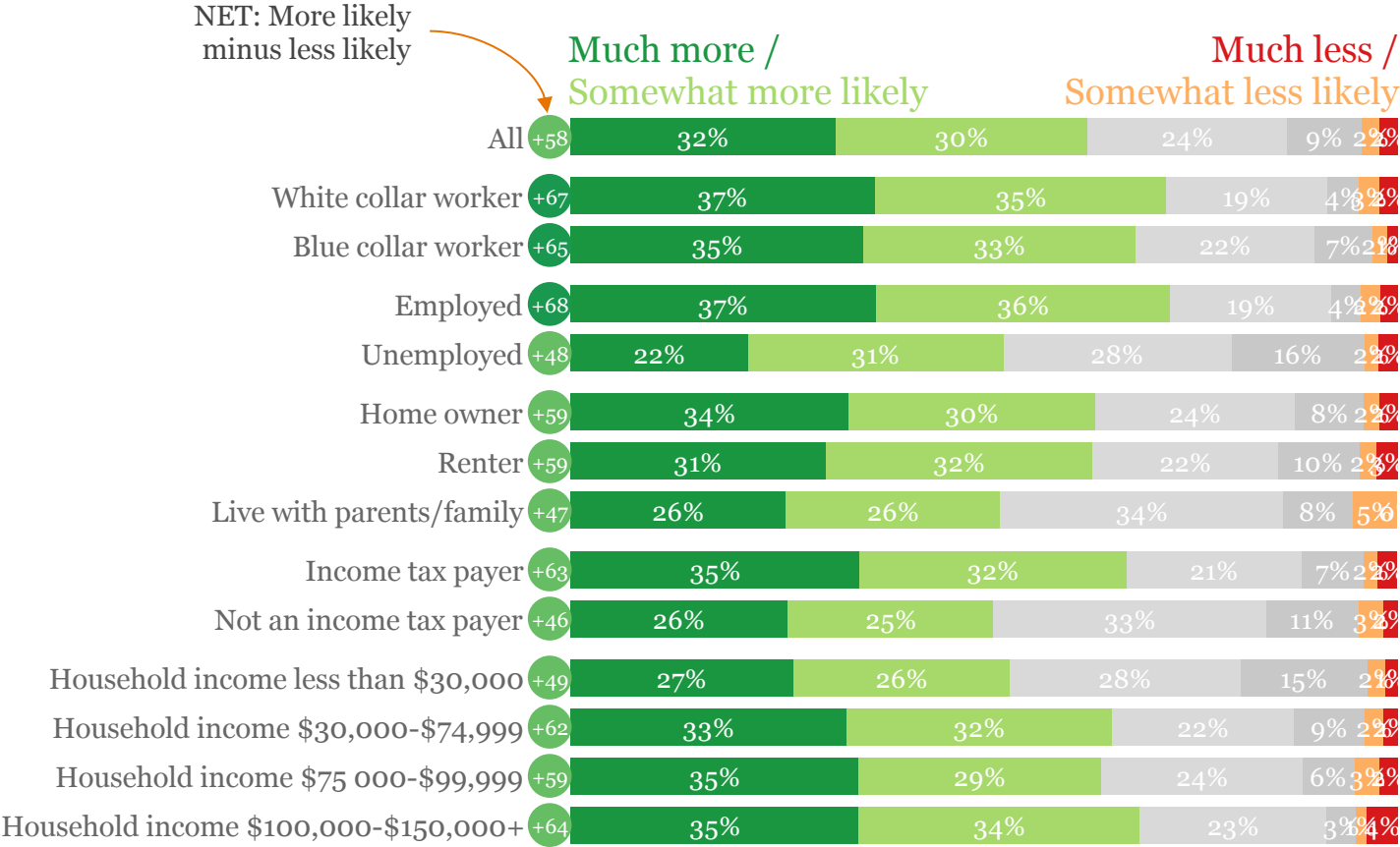

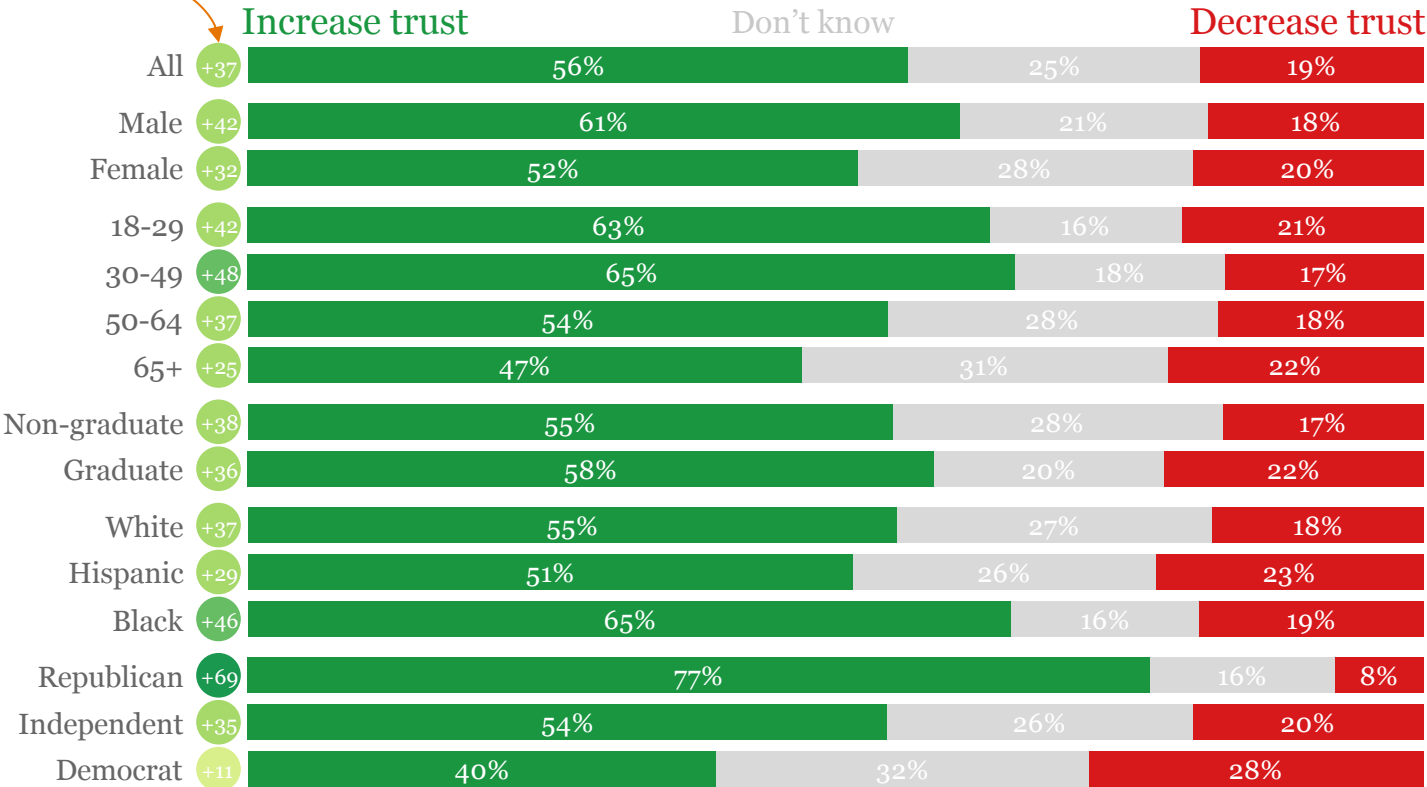

Would receiving a \$5,000 check funded by eliminating waste, fraud, and abuse in government spending increase or decrease your trust and confidence in the United States government?

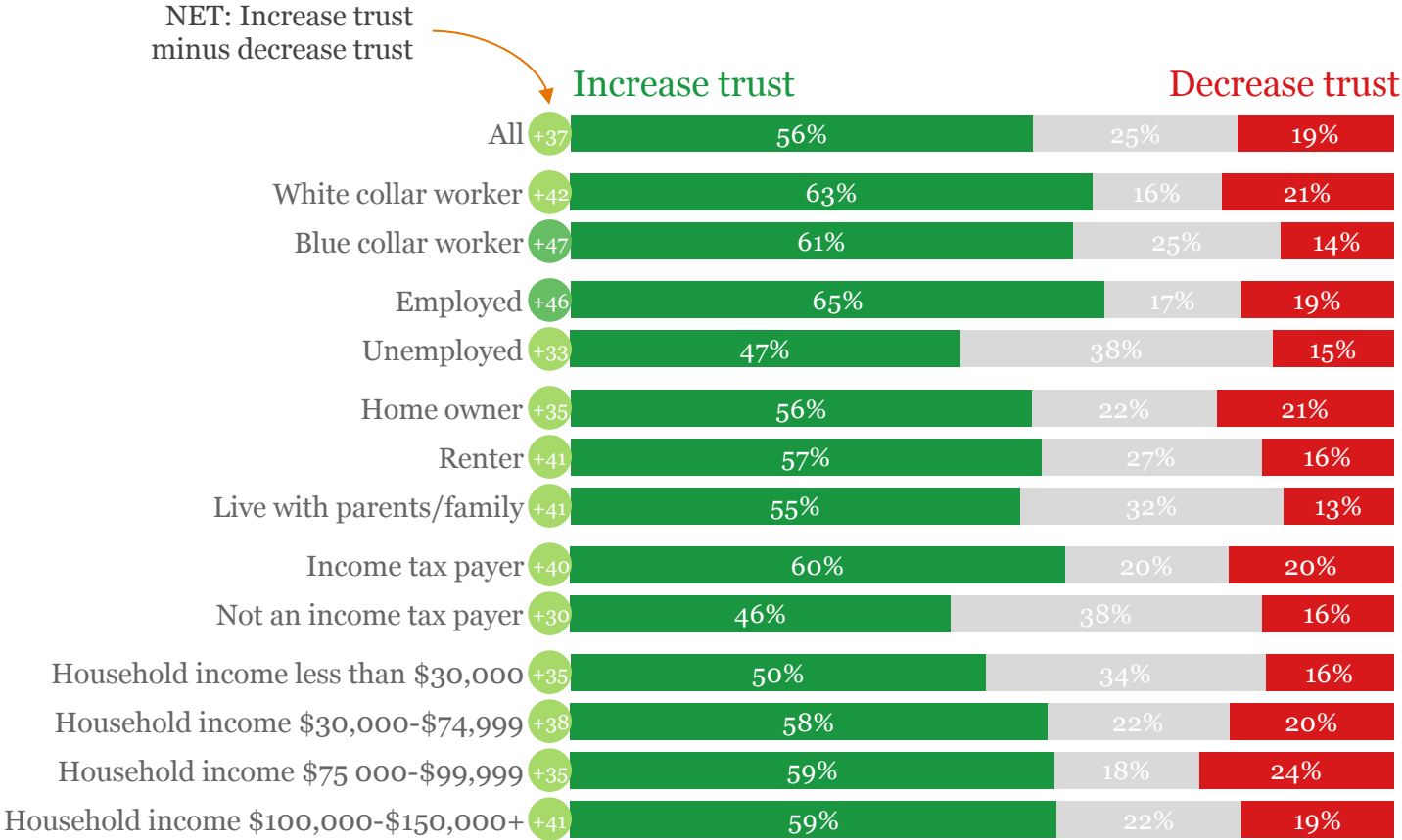

Those with a higher house-hold income are more likely to say it will increase their trust in the government

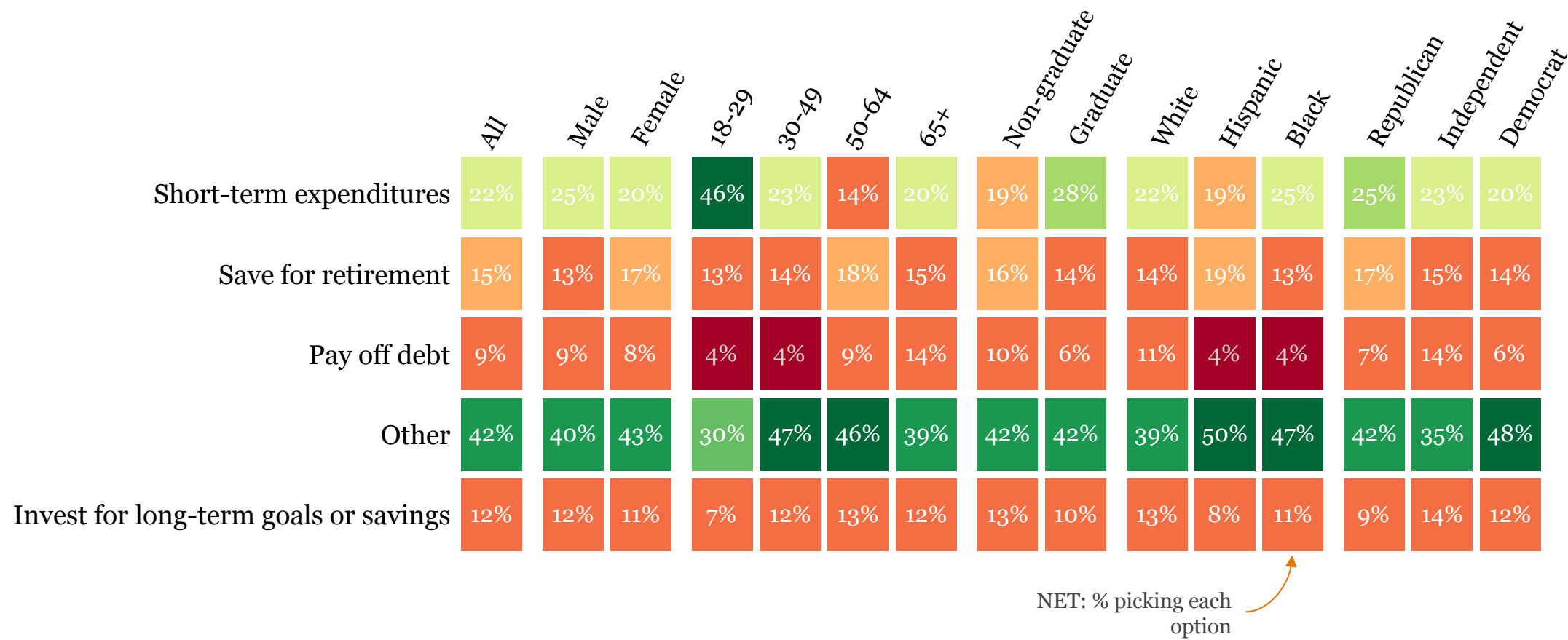

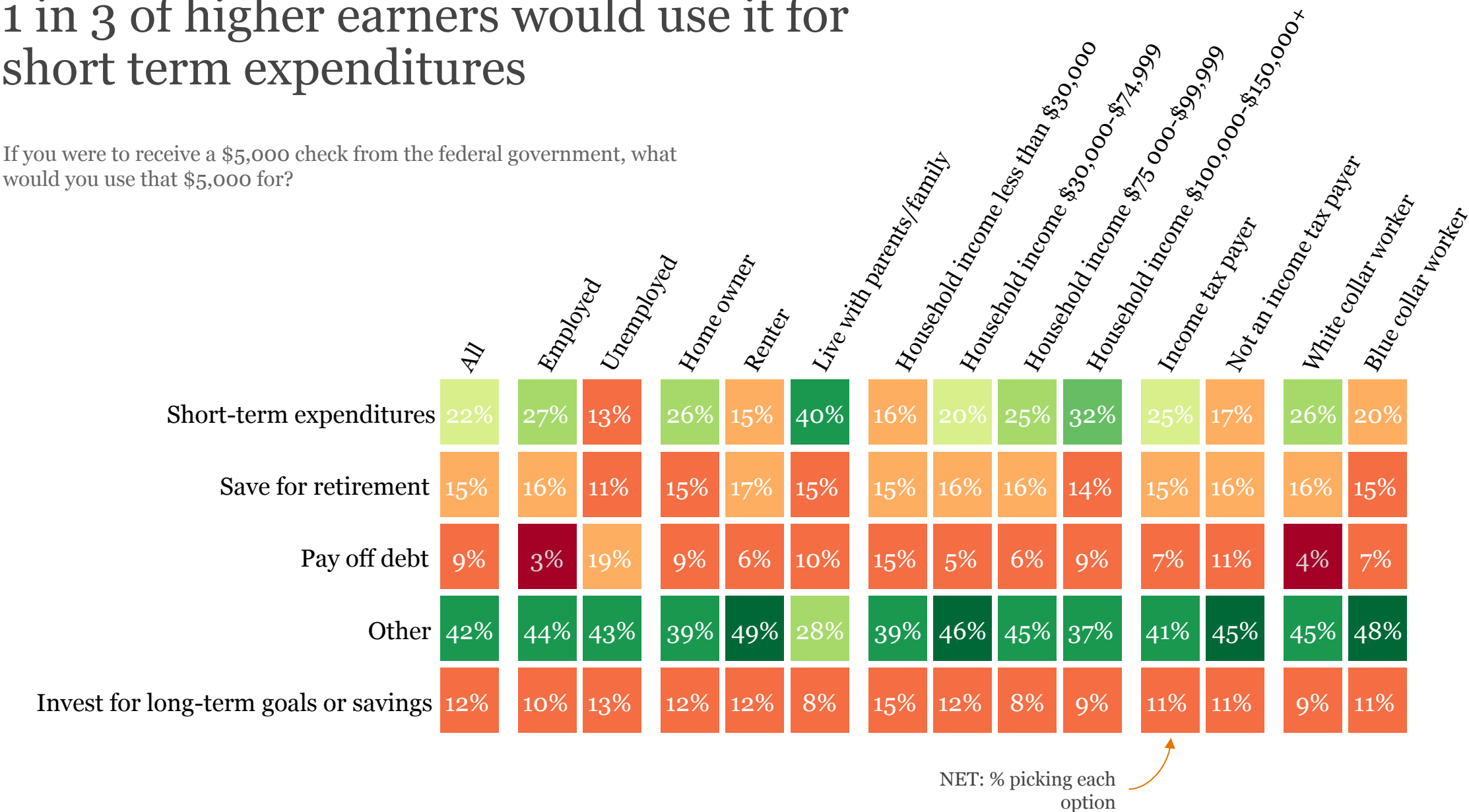

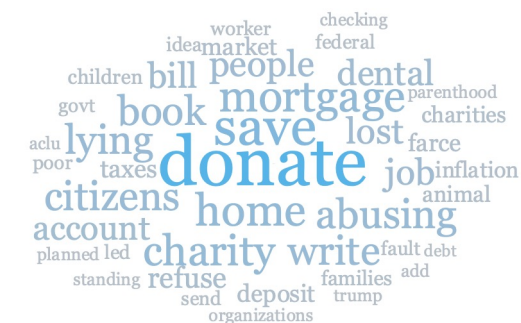

By household income



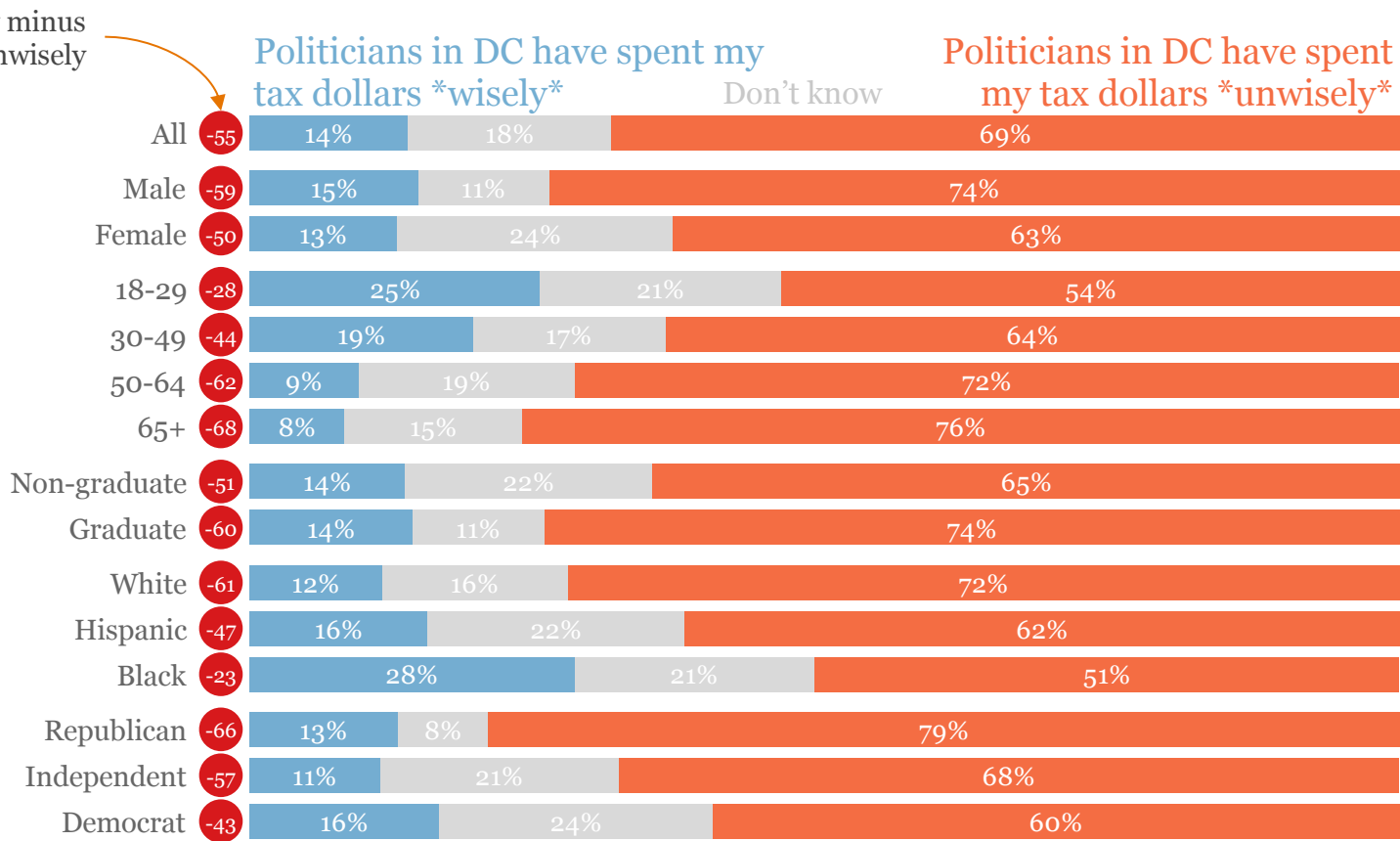

7 in 10 Americans say politicians have spent their tax dollars unwisely, including 6 in 10 Democrats

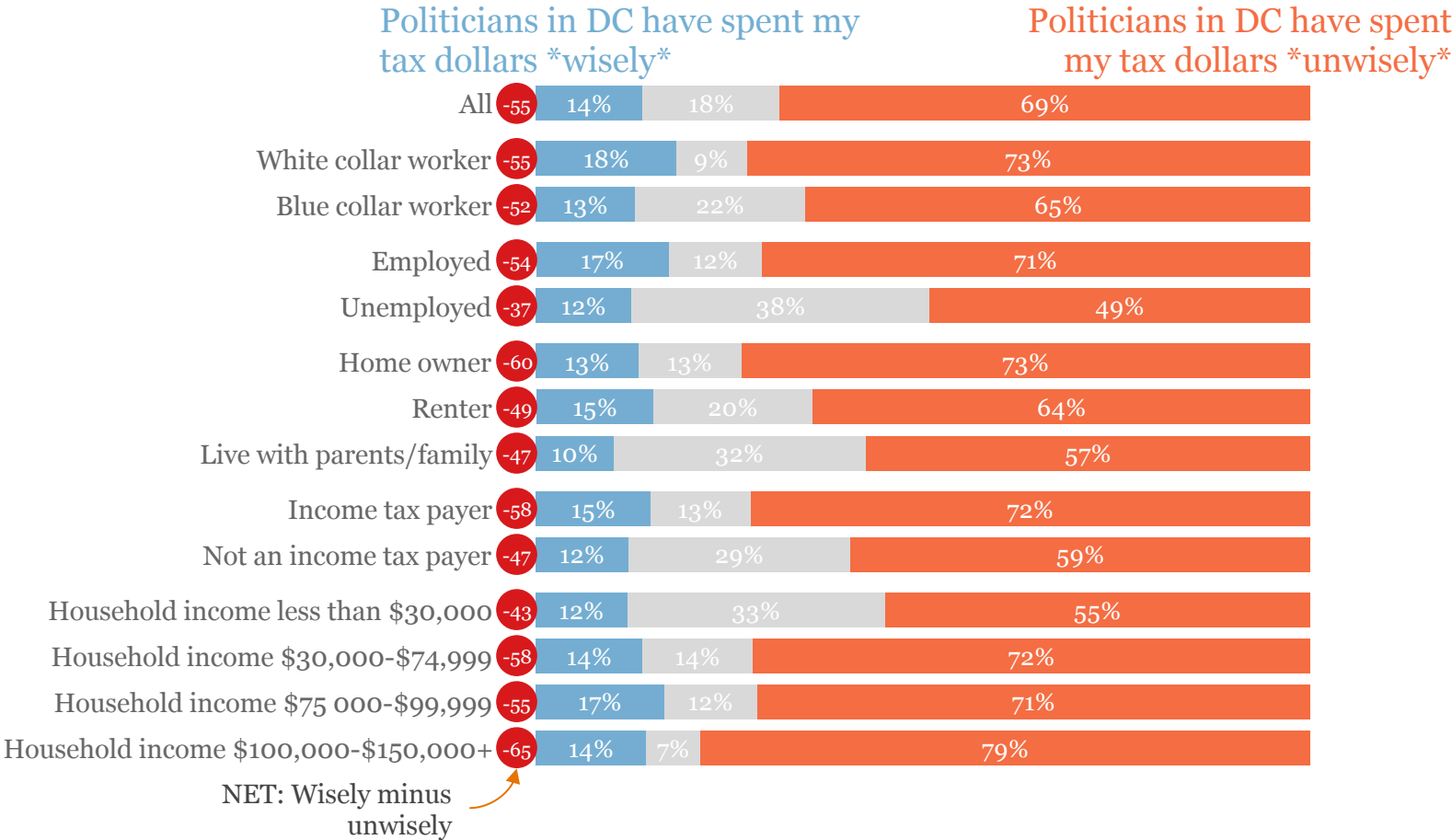

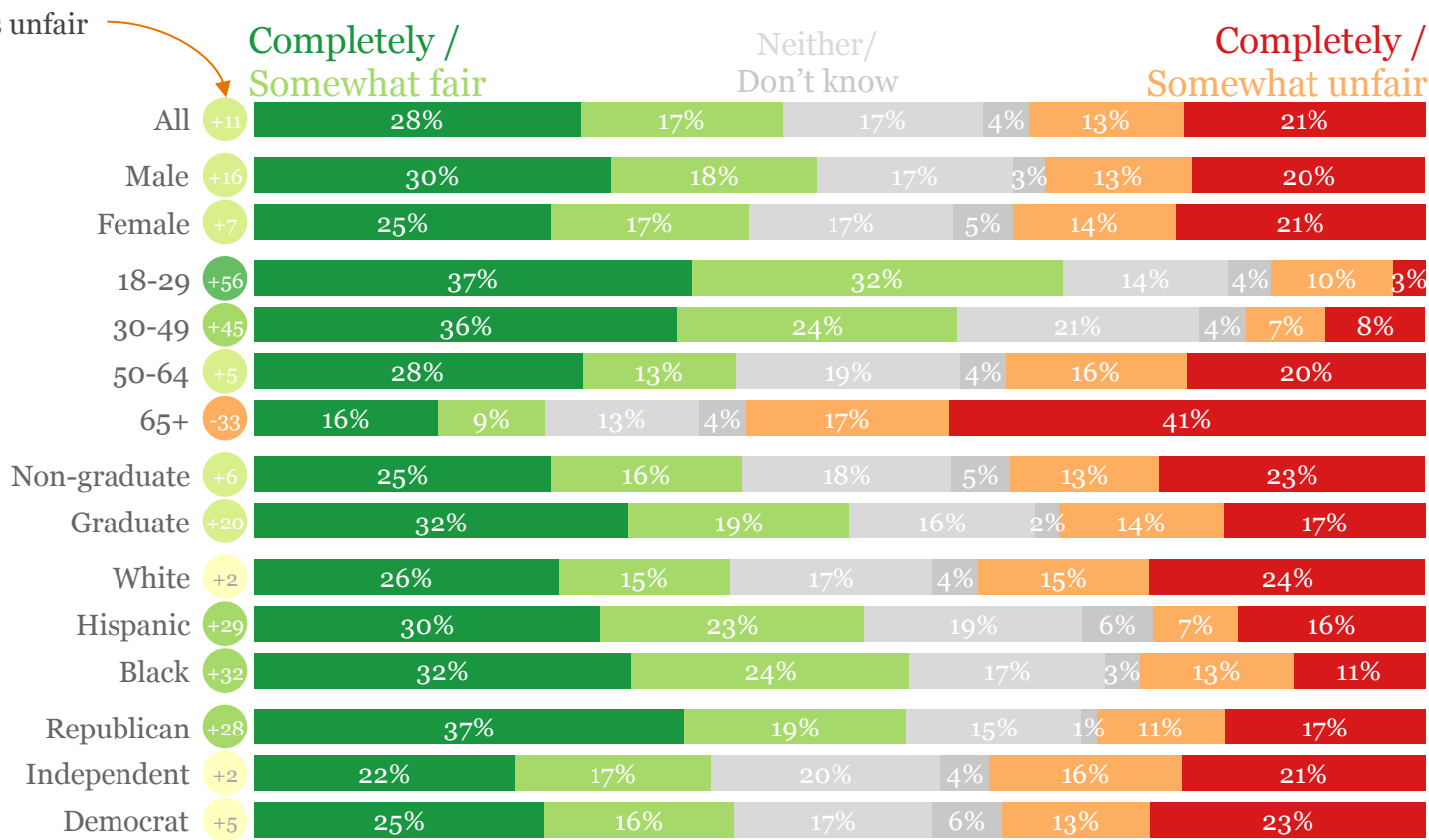

All groups apart from the over-65s think that it is fair that only tax-payers would receive the check

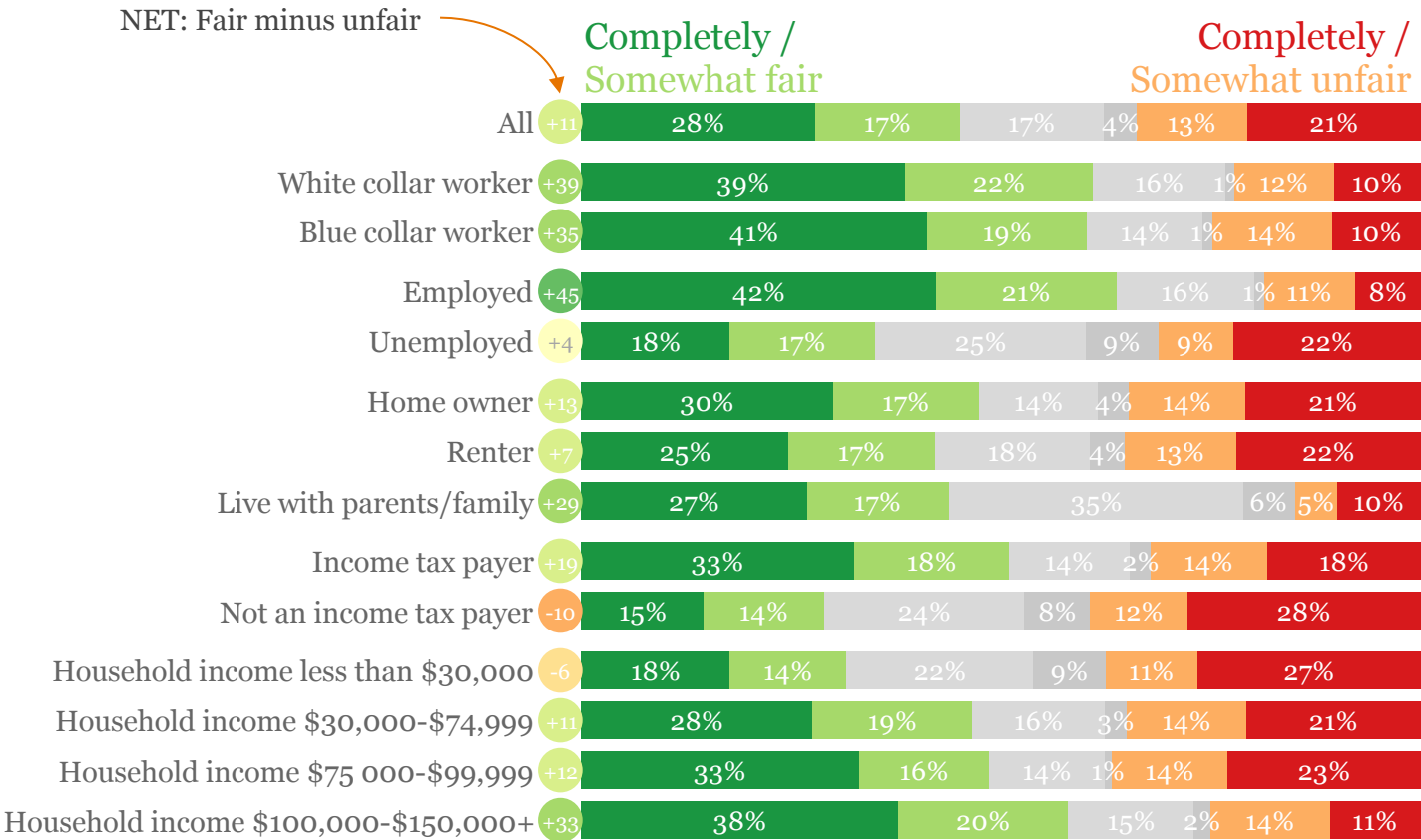

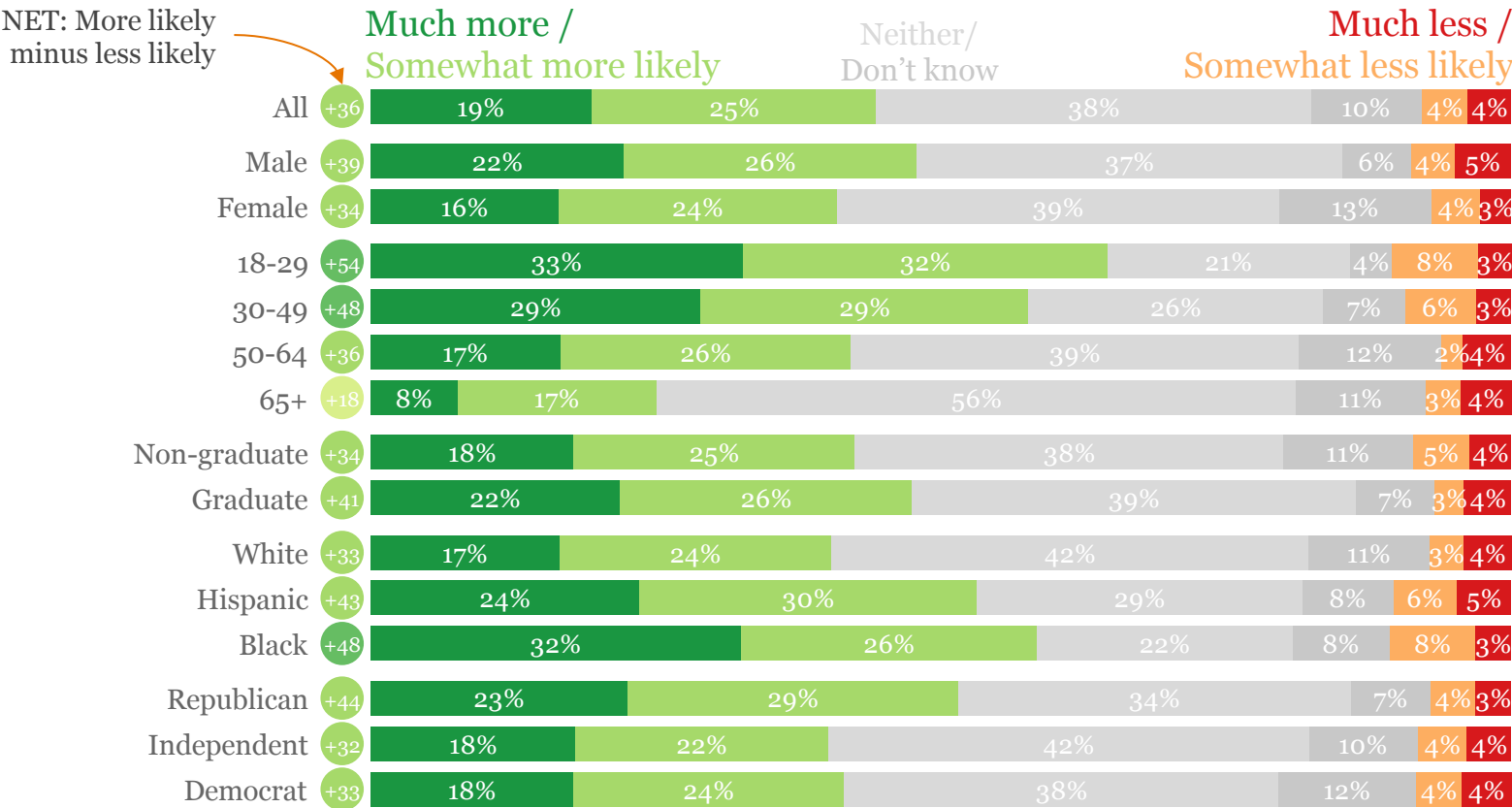

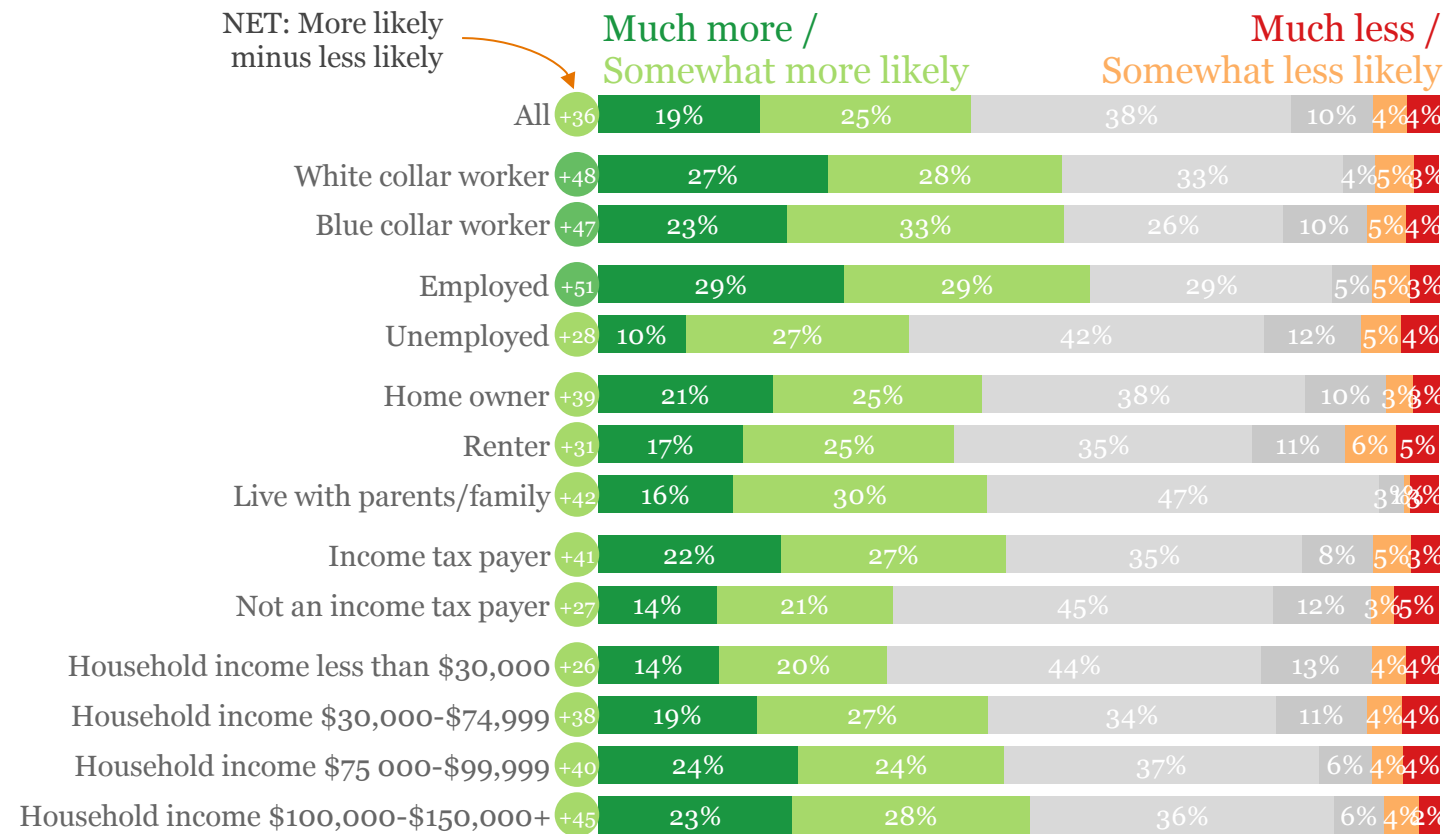
Americans, including both Republicans and Democrats, believe the check would incentivize people to enter/re-enter the workforce

Almost 4 in 10 of those currently not working say the dividend will make those not working more likely to enter the workforce

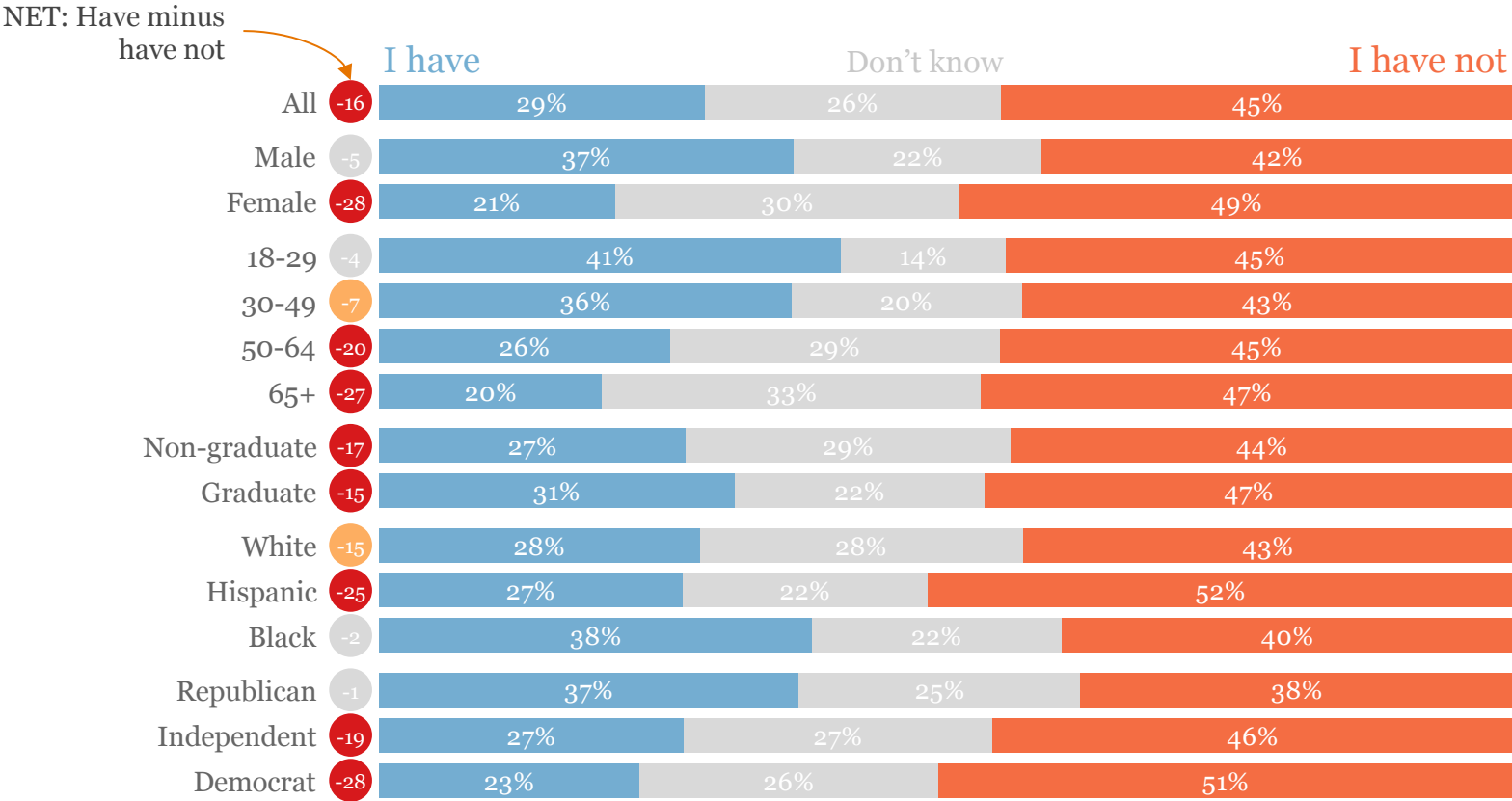

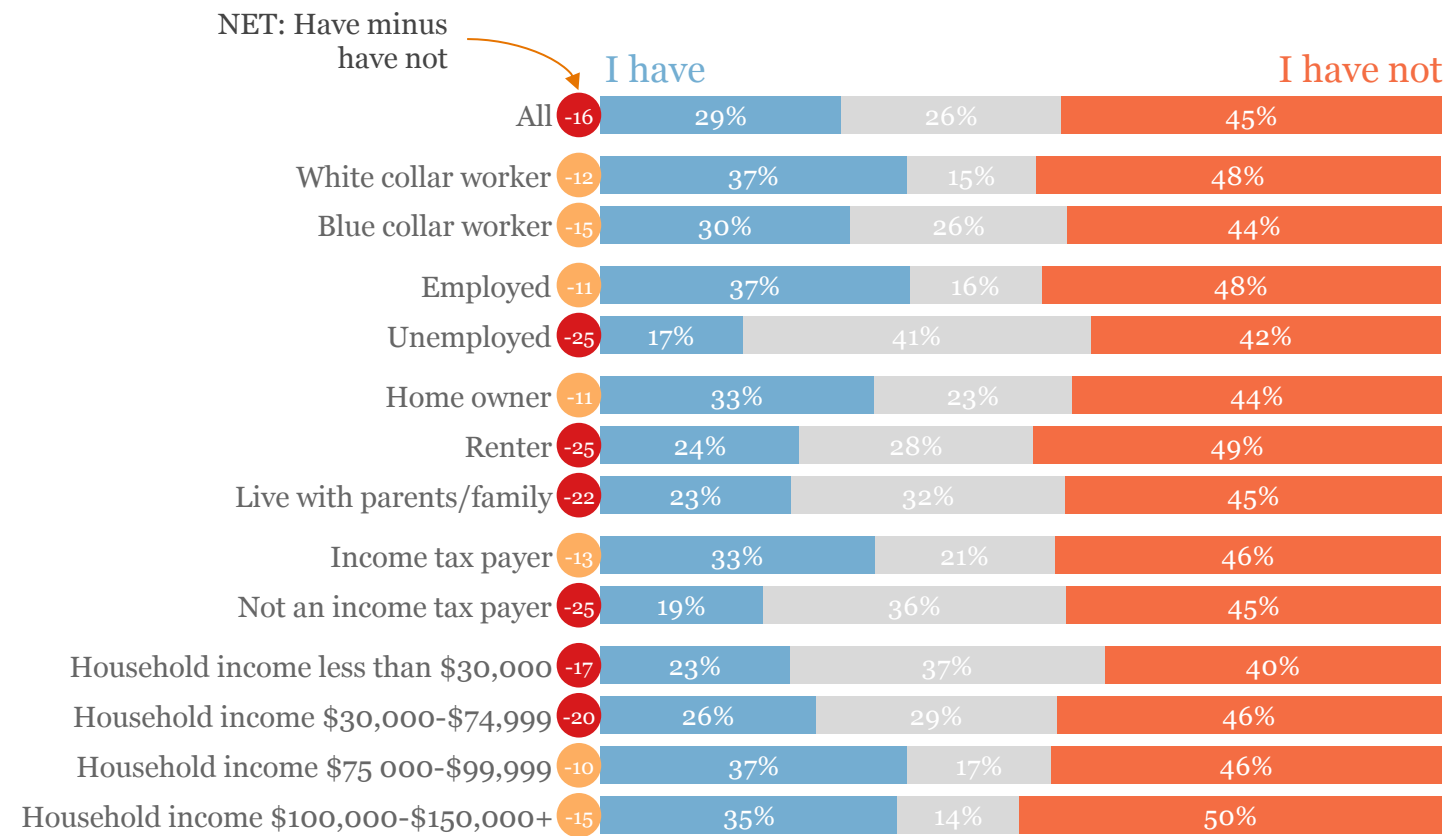

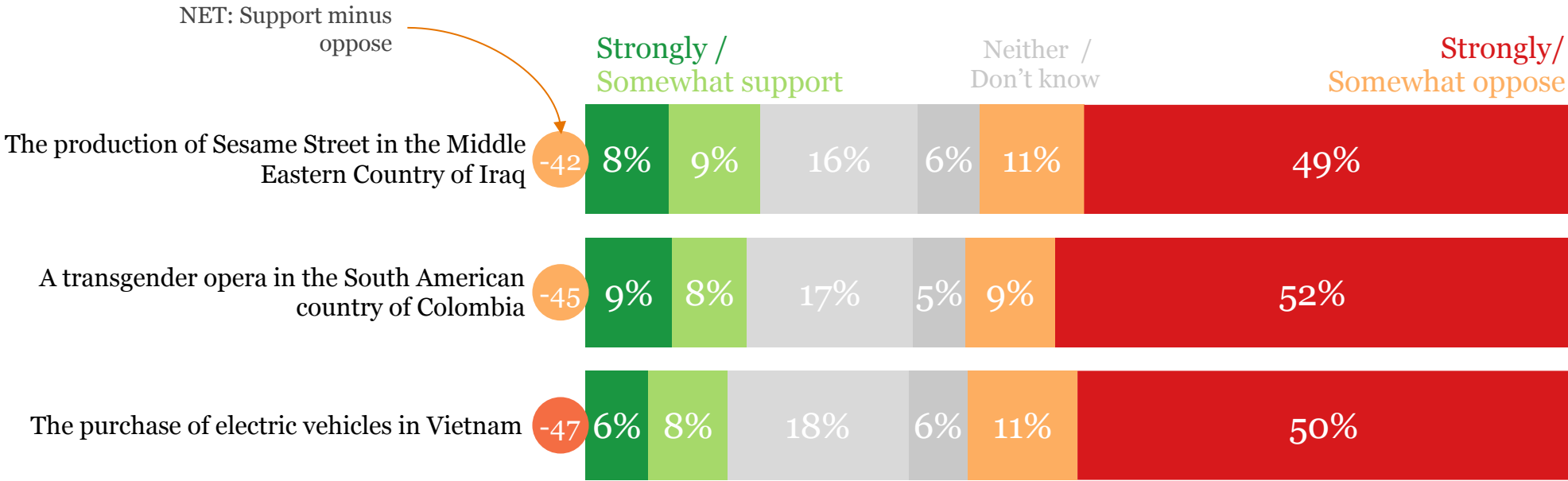

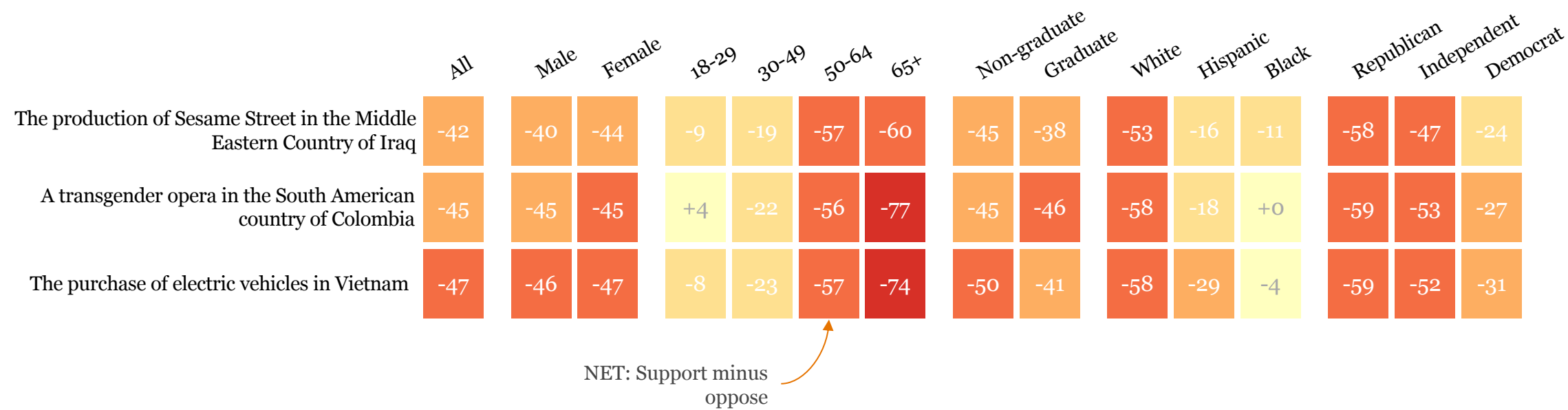

Do you support or oppose American tax dollars being used to fund the following?



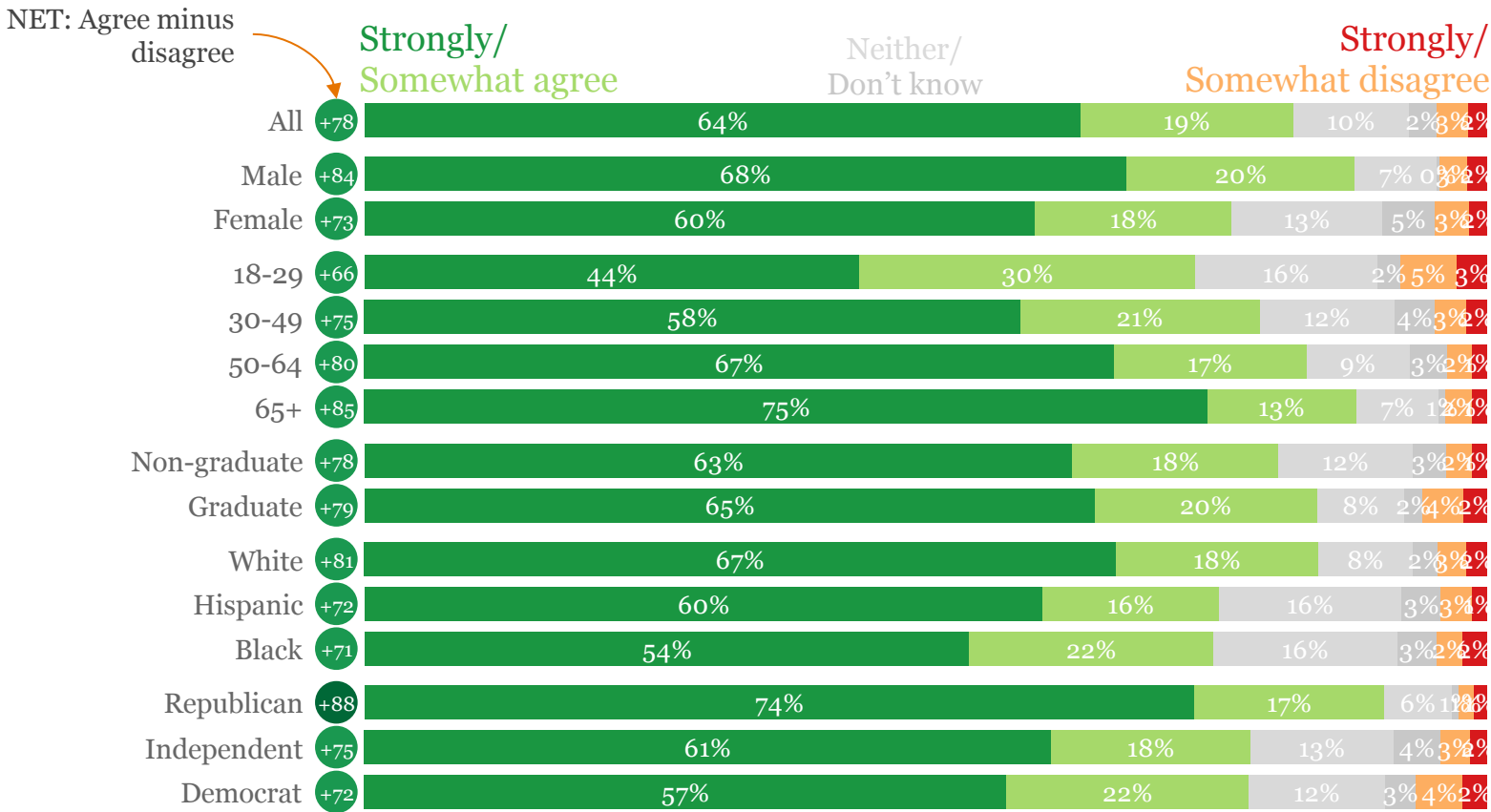

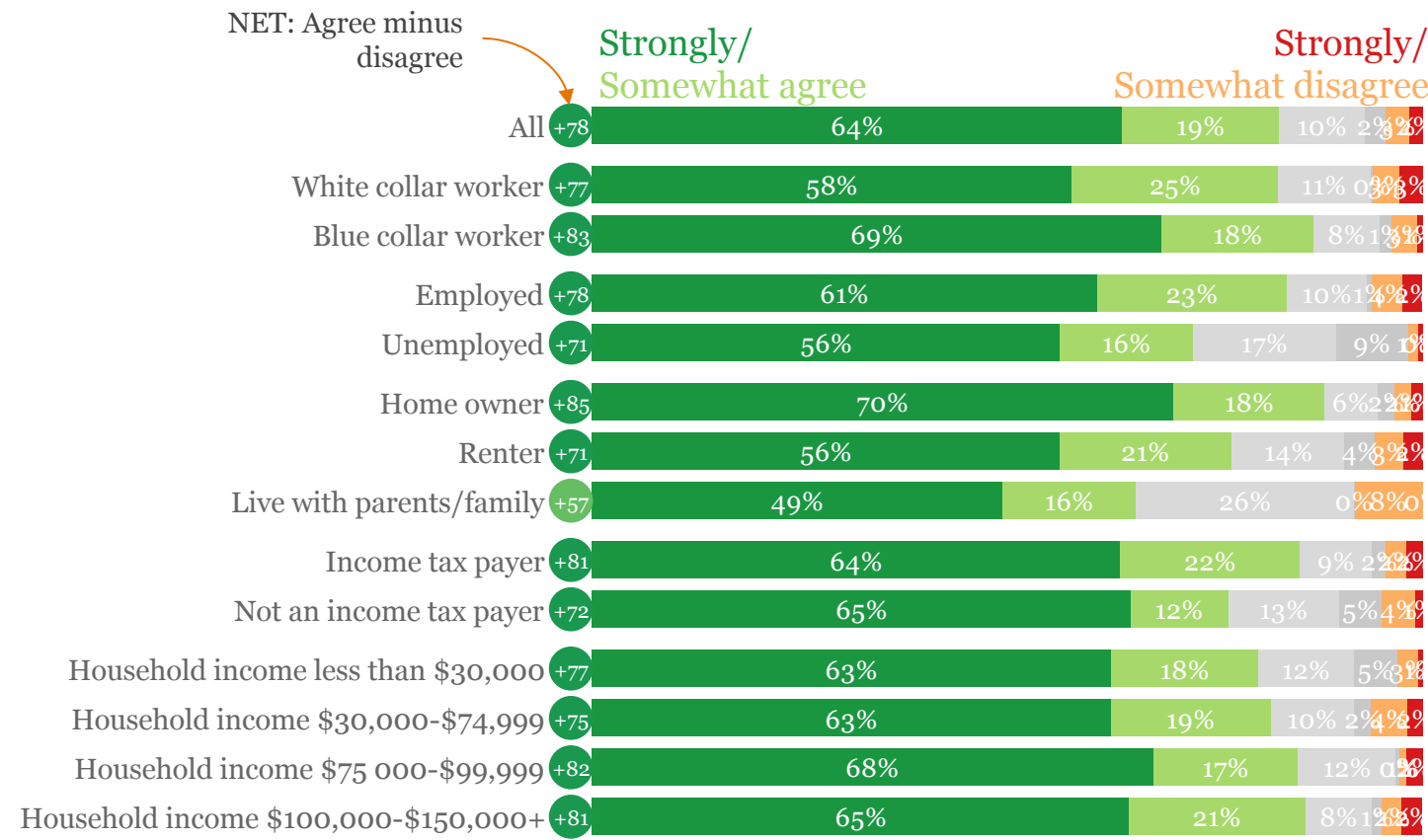

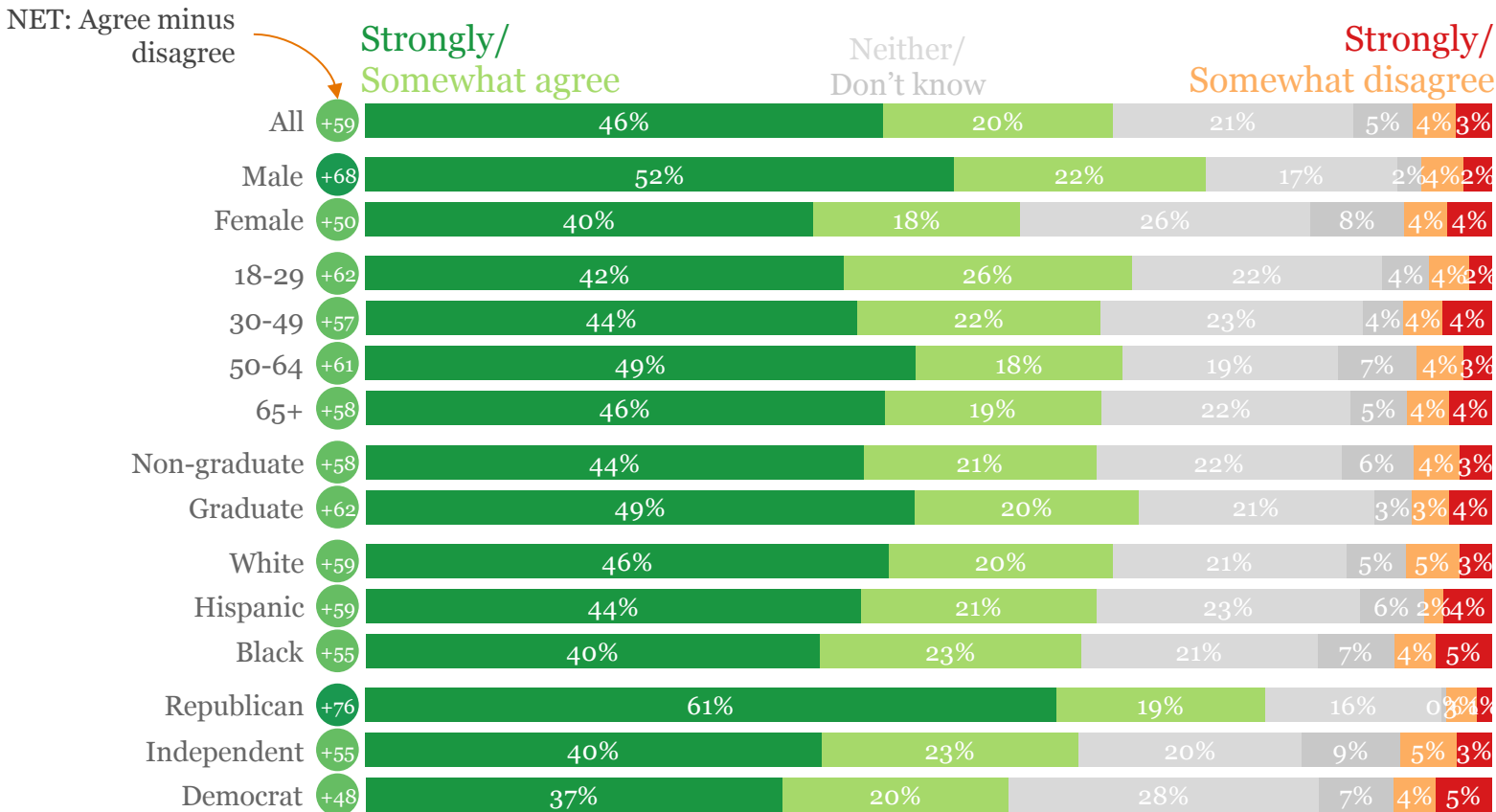

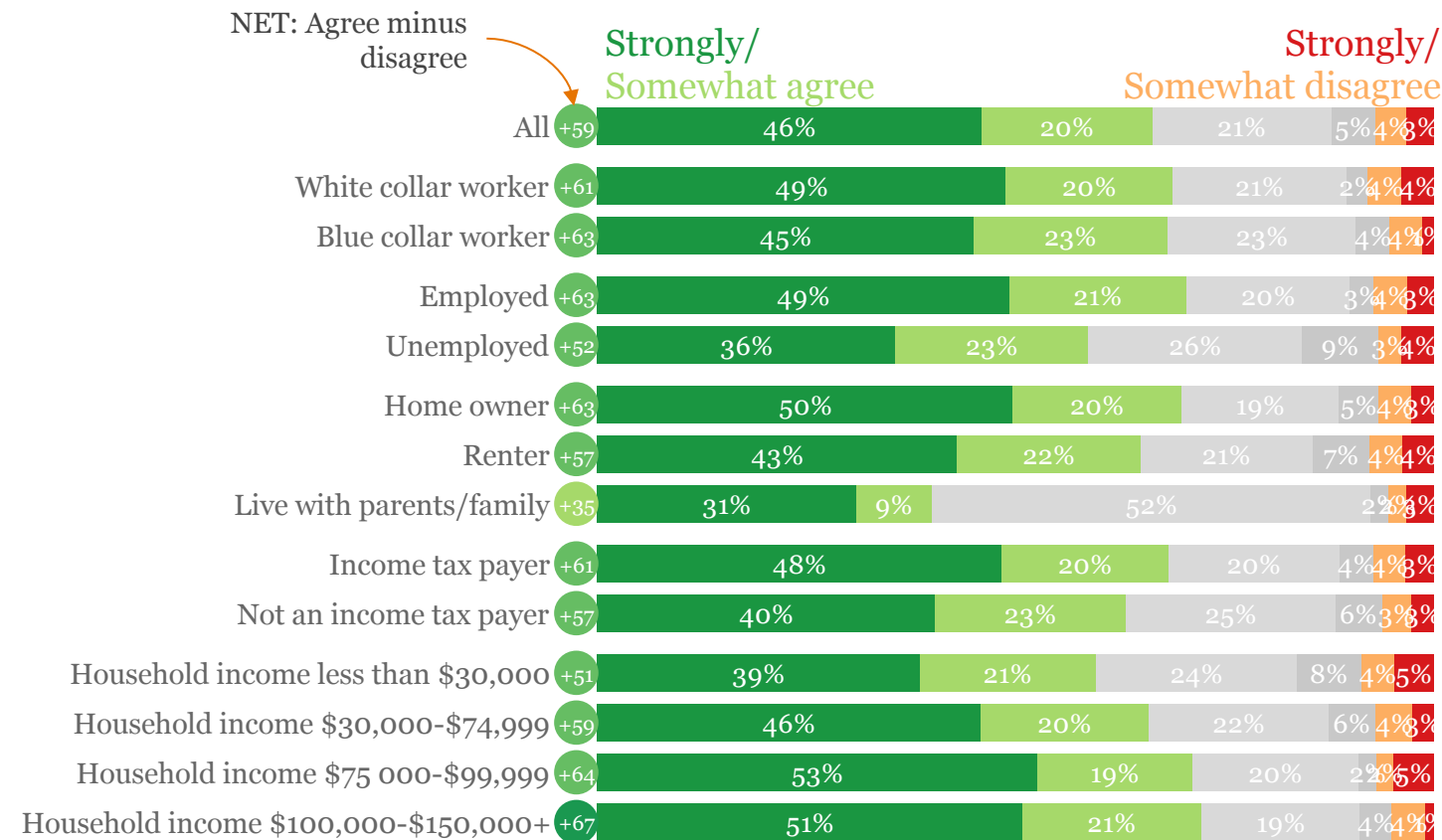
