3. Campaign Treasurer's Report - Miami-Dade County Electronic Filing Requirement (Form MD-ED 10)

According to Rule 9 (B.) of the Party Rules of Procedure for the Republican Paty of Florida, each Republican Executive Committee member required by this Rule to sign a party loyalty oath must file the oath with the Chairman of his or her respective State or County Republican Executive Committee (or the Chairman's designee) no later than 30 days after election to party office. The party loyalty oath shall be witnessed, verified, or notarized.

There is no need to resign from elected or appointed office to run for this office [F.S. 112.046].
