ALICE Active Shooter Training Drill Best Practices

Active shooter drill requirements may vary in your state. Use the following best practices as guidelines:

- Understand the difference between drills and scenarios
- Practice all types of drills: lockdown, evacuate, tabletop (using critical thinking drill cards)
- Drills should be led by an ALICE Certified Instructor (ACI) or member of law enforcement
- Drills should NEVER be unannounced

- Drills should be age- and abilityappropriate
- Drills can be uncomfortable ensure the use of a trauma-informed approach to alleviate some of the stress
- Complete a <u>drill log</u>
- Check with local or state government for specific drill requirements

Emergency Operations Plan Best Practices

- Ensure the EOP is updated annually
- Does the EOP identify a point of contact, rally point, and strategies for Inform?
