SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The vessel is carrying two containers of contraband (designated as "A" and "B"). Contraband in "A" is not cocaine or even drugs but something else valuable like illegal gems, animals, animal parts, or artifacts. I was not able to determine the type of contraband in "B".

Container "A" is full of stacks of gray cans which contain a very thick, viscous, foul-tasting liquid (something I had never tasted before.) The contraband is located in a long, green, metal box on the floor of the container near the center. This is completely surrounded by the cans. Inside the metal box are some kind of smuggled valuables. Container "A" is located approximately 8 containers from the top (count down disregarding decks, etc.,) 6 containers from port and 15 containers forward of stern.

Container "B" is full of rolls of carpet or material which is brightly colored and patterned with repetitive, geometric shaped designs in yellow or beige. Contraband is in select roll(s) that have a cylindrically shaped cavity cut out of the interior. The color green (couldn't tell if wrapping, or letters, or color of fabric) is somehow associated with the contraband containing roll(s). "B" is located 8 containers from top, 4 from port and 17 from the stern.
