SUBJECT: SUN STREAK Report - 9017

TO: BRANCH CHIEF, DT-S

(S/STD/NF) From 10-14 April 1990, four remote viewers (# 025, 032, 049, and 079) conducted a total of one CRV and three SOLO sessions in an effort to answer requirements against the SG1A suspected narcotics smuggling vessel known as customer provided the following EEI:

- Is the vessel carrying contraband narcotics, if so, n fiis where on board is it stored?
- If not will it on-load contraband in b. the very near If yes, provide details. future?
- Determine the current location and heading of the vessel.
- Determine the date, time and location where the contraband marcotics will be unloaded/transferred.
 - Determine and describe the vessel's route of travel.
- 025 reported that the vessel is carrying (S/STD/NF) contraband narcotics which are stored in a wall cabinet to the left of a stairwell/room near the bow, just below the deck. drugs are contained in small duffel bags. The vessel is currently (12 0845-0945L APR 90) located at 14 30' N 71 W. The drugs will be off-loaded at 17 N 67 W, near Puerto Rico. are Spanish men on board the vessel.
- (S/STD/NF) 032 reported that the vessel is not currently (11 1030L APR 90) carrying contraband. It has that capability, but whether or not that shall occur depends on decisions yet to be made. There is an intelligence net that will make this decision based on risk data available. The vessel is currently (same time) located at 17 07' N $\,$ 64 09' W, heading 230 degrees. The vessel is heading toward its destination of 12 03' N 71 01' W (Puerto Estrella, Colombia.)

- (S/STD/NF) 049 reported that the vessel is currently carrying contraband within one or more large shipping containers located in the last row, along the port side of the deck cargo There are crates within these shipping container(s). The contraband consists of both narcotics and automatic arms/weapons. These are not located together. The crate containing the narcotics contains a number of smaller blue and white stacked metal containers. These metal containers are truncated with rounded coffiers: dimensions are: length: 8-10"; narrow end: 3-4"; wide end: 8"; thickness: 6". These containers normally contain animal products or meat. Some of these cans co contain meat, however, others contain a dry substance. This substance is encased with orange wrapping with a blue label stamped on the outside. This is, in turn, surrounded by a very dense, clay-like material. This composite is then sealed within the can. All of the metal containers, meat and otherwise, look identical. The vessel is currently (10 1230L APR 90) located at 14 45' N 67 33' W, heading northwesterly.
- 5. (S/STD/NF) 079 reported that the vessel is carrying contraband narcotics which are located below deck just above the waterline near the stern (C-8 on the notional ship grid). The current (11 9000-1000L APR 90) location of the vessel is 13 N 65 W, heading northwesterly. The vessel will be travelling toward the Gulf of Mexico for the off-loading of the drugs.
