An Account of the Chemical Division's Contacts in the Mational Institute of Health

- 1. Through the efficient cooperation of the Lidson & Security Officer/753, it was made possible for Draws and and another to visit various people in the Entironal Institute of Esolth and the UNFHS Hospital at Lexington, Mentucky on 8 July 1953. The purpose of this visit was to inform them, in a secure manner, of our interest in and support of the research program of Dr. Entris Isbell.
- 2. Dr. William Sebrell, Director of N.I.H., was informed of the defensive aspects of the Agency's interest in Dr. Isbell's program and of our financial support of it. No details of the research program and indicated that he would afford us full support and protection. He advised us that'Dr. James Shannon should be cleared by the Agency in order to make secure the administrative side of the program.
- 3. Mr. Morse, the Security Chief of the Department of Health, Education and Welfure, was also visited for the purpose of informing him of our visit to Lexington and to obtain his view on our relationship to Dr. Chayman at the Lexington Heapital. He informed us that he had talked to Dr. Chayman and had ascertained that Chayman would be more than willing to drop any interest or connection that he had ever had in our project. Further, Mr. Morse said that he would call Dr. Chayman on the telephone prior to our arrival at Lexington, inform him of our visit, and confirm this position.
- 4. Later that day, Dr. Harris Isbell was visited at the U. S. Public Bealth Service Respital at Lexington, Mentucky.
