# Training Session Descriptions & POST C.E.H.

#### Missouri Law Enforcement Funeral Assistance - 1 Hour TS Wednesday 11:00 a.m.

Scott Barthelmass, a Corporal with the Overland (Missouri) Police Department, and founder of the Missouri Law Enforcement Funeral Assistance Team will speak on this valuable resource to assist the agencies and families of a fallen officer. The funeral team was created in 2008 and is making available resources such as a Missouri state specific line of duty death manual, personnel to plan and carry out a memorial services, and soon a resource trailer for agencies across the state. Scott will talk about what has gone into developing the team, current undertakings, what the team is planning for the future and how it can benefit your agency. (*Presenter: Scott Barthelmass*)

#### Reducing Inmate Healthcare Cost - 1.5 Hours TS Wednesday 12:30 p.m.

Is the cost of inmate healthcare killing your budget? Are you constantly battling law suits relating to inmate healthcare issues? Is your staff properly trained to deal with medical issues? In his presentation, Dr. Johnson discusses strategies for reducing your healthcare cost, as well as your liability exposure. Learn the difference between necessary and optional treatment; proper sick call techniques; how to develop a cost containment program and how to reduce risk. (*Presenter: Dr. Norm Johnson*)

#### COPLINK/MODEX - 1 Hour TS Thursday 8:30 a.m.

The Missouri Data Exchange (MoDEx) is a statewide data warehouse developed to provide information for crime leads to Missouri law enforcement agencies. The MoDEx system uses the COPLINK software to provide the ability to search, link, analyze and share criminal justice information such as incidents/case reports, incarceration data, computer-aided dispatch, photos, citations, collisions and pawn data on a statewide basis. MoDEx will eventually interface with the National Data Exchange (N-DEx), a nationwide data sharing initiative administered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. A demonstration of the COPLINK software will be provided at this presentation. (*Presenters: Carolyn Kampeter*)

#### Minding the Gap - 2 Hours IP Thursday 10:00 a.m.

Before a person gets ready for a hearty physical exertion a coach or trainer will often encourage the participant to take a deep breath – inhale/exhale and then they'll be ready for the next strenuous activity. What does that deep breath look like before one takes on a new job, a new challenge, or a new year? This session discusses the pitfalls of being in a rush, being over-confident and missing the little things. (*Presenters: Pieter Van Waarde*)

#### Collective Bargaining: What Every Law Enforcement Executive Needs to Know 2-Hours LS Thursday 1:30 p.m.

This course provides an overview of the recent Missouri Supreme Court case granting all employees the collective bargaining rights, including POLICE OFFICERS and DEPUTY SHERIFFS. It offers insight into what to expect, how to deal with bargaining units, contract negotiations and what is needed to prepare for union activities in law enforcement agencies. #### The Role of Sheriffs as Corners - 1 Hour TS Thursday 4:00 p.m.

This session begins with a brief overview of the history and mission of the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control. It then moves on to information relating to legal updates, statutes and regulations concerning alcohol and tobacco laws. It concludes with the criteria for conducting compliance checks and a hands-on opportunity for learning how to identify altered or false identification cards. (*Presenter: Ivra Cross*)

#### Developing a Defensible Policy & Procedure Manual - 2 Hours TS Friday 8:00 a.m

Are the policies and procedures of your organization included in a single manual? Is that a good thing? Do you provide clear written guidelines for how you want your staff to behave and how you want them to perform their duties? This session provides information relating to the need for good manuals, the need to training your staff on the manuals and the liability associated with not ensuring the guidelines in the manuals are followed. #### Fleet Management - 2 Hours TS Friday 10:00 a.m.

Each year vehicle accidents kill roughly 42,000 people on American highways. Around 1,000 people die on Missouri highways each year. Vehicle accidents are the number one killer of employees in almost all industries, including law enforcement and emergency services. Based on an OSHA 10-step program, Missouri Employers Mutual's Fleet Safety presentation expands on best practices that employers can use to reduce their exposure to vehicle accidents, injuries and fatalities.
