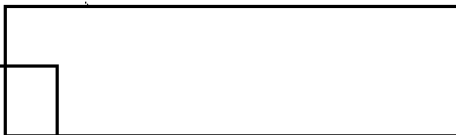

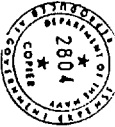

SG1A TASK: (3 JUL 90) Describe airfield, any aircraft at the field, and any airdrop activity and locations of projected drops.

REPLIES: -- ⁷⁹ OOC reported an airdrop completed on 2 July by a lightweight, Cessna-like aircraft, which would perform another A/D within 5 days near Puerto Rico in the early evening hours.

-- ⁹⁵ OOE reported the aircraft would perform an airdrop near Puerto Rico (approx. 1823N 6513W) during the night of 3-4 JUL 90.

-- ⁴⁹ OOF included details of two aircraft on the field involved in a loading operation (green dufflebags probably carrying cocaine, being loaded into the aircraft).

-- One source reported a small vessel was loitering around an abandoned or sunken dock or freighter, and that the activity would occur between 010001 and 010600.

CASE RESULTS

- UNABLE TO CORRELATE 66% (39) OF CASES
DATA TOO DIVERSE (MAJORITY)
NO ASSETS AVAILABLE (MINORITY)
- OF 34% (20 TOTAL) ABLE TO CORRELATE:
 - 30% (6) HAD NO CORRELATION TO KNOWN DATA
 - 45% (9) HAD SOME CORRELATION
 - 25% (5) HAD STRONG CORRELATION TO KNOWN DATA
- NO CORRELATIONS TO VESSEL LOCATIONS (SEARCH)
